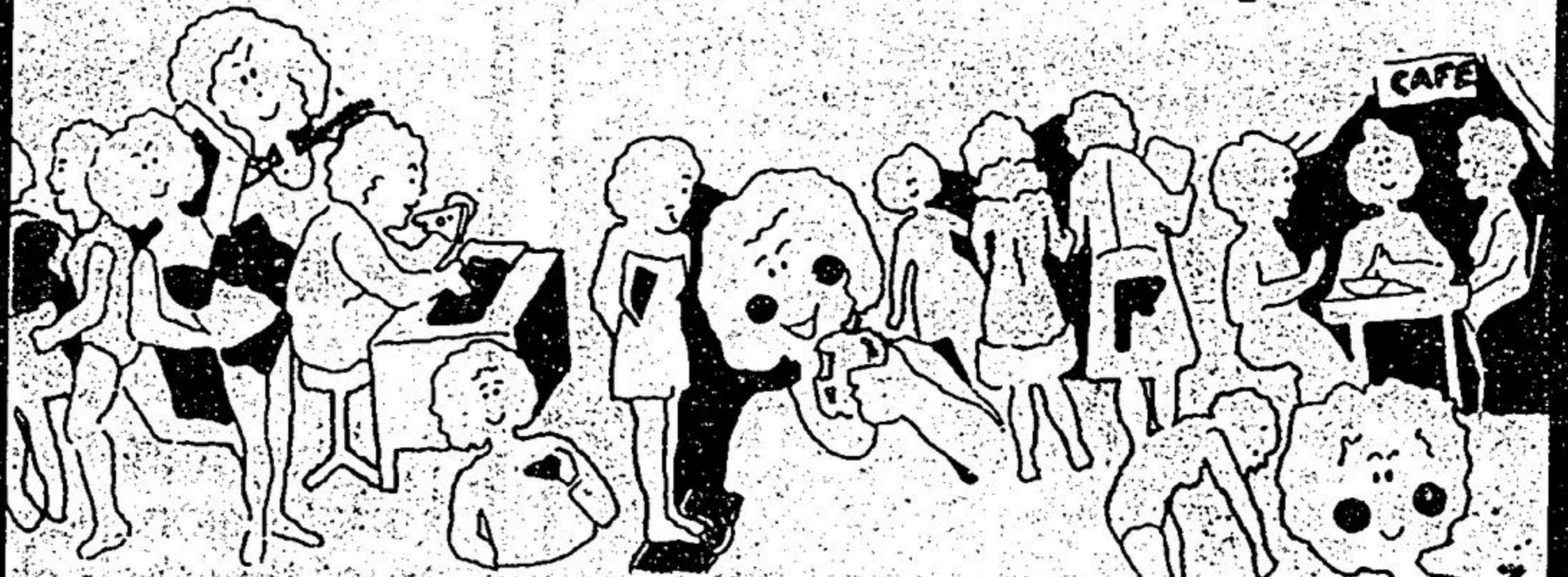
Diabetes meeting
