McIntyre funeral today

 The tragic crash of the National Defence helicopter in Timmins Thursday, took the life of Stephen McIntyre, son of Ronald McIntyre and Marilyn (Slack) Hoskin of Port Perry. Stephen was one of four crew members killed during a trial run from Petawawa to Kapuskasing.

Heartfelt sympathy from the many friends in Goodwood go out to these families as well as to Stephen's grandmother, Gladys Slack.

The funeral service was held in Port Perry at the Scugog Funeral Parlor, today at 2 p.m.

Beholding his dark shadow on the frozen snow,

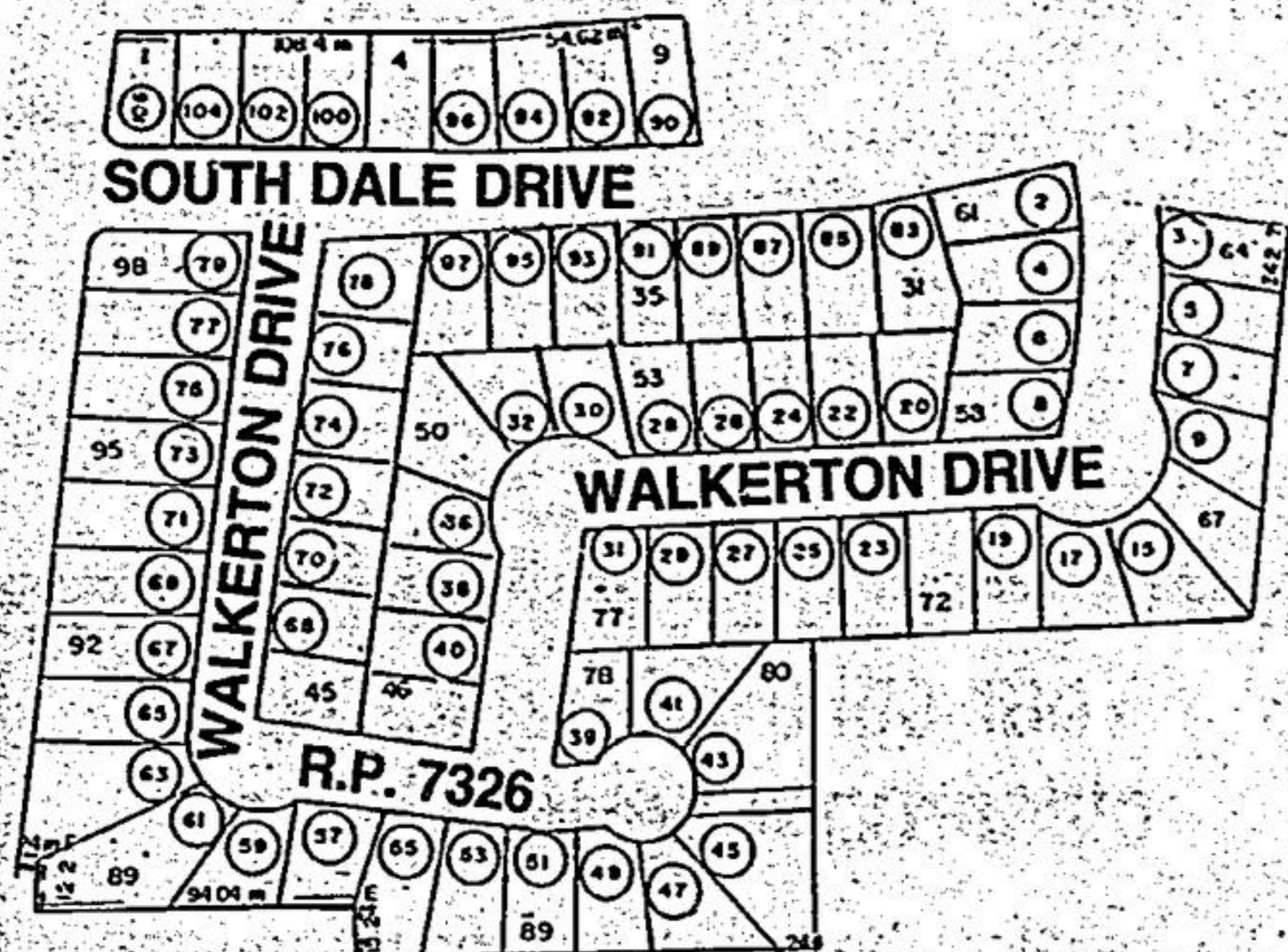
Back to his den for six long weeks doth go.

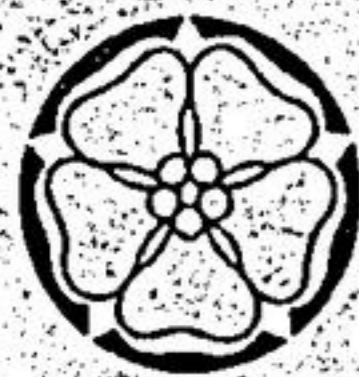

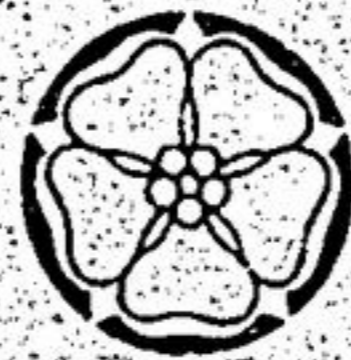
