The Valentine's Dance features the Disc Jockey services of Joey Boreland. The festivities start at 8:30 p.m. There is a \$5 admission fee.

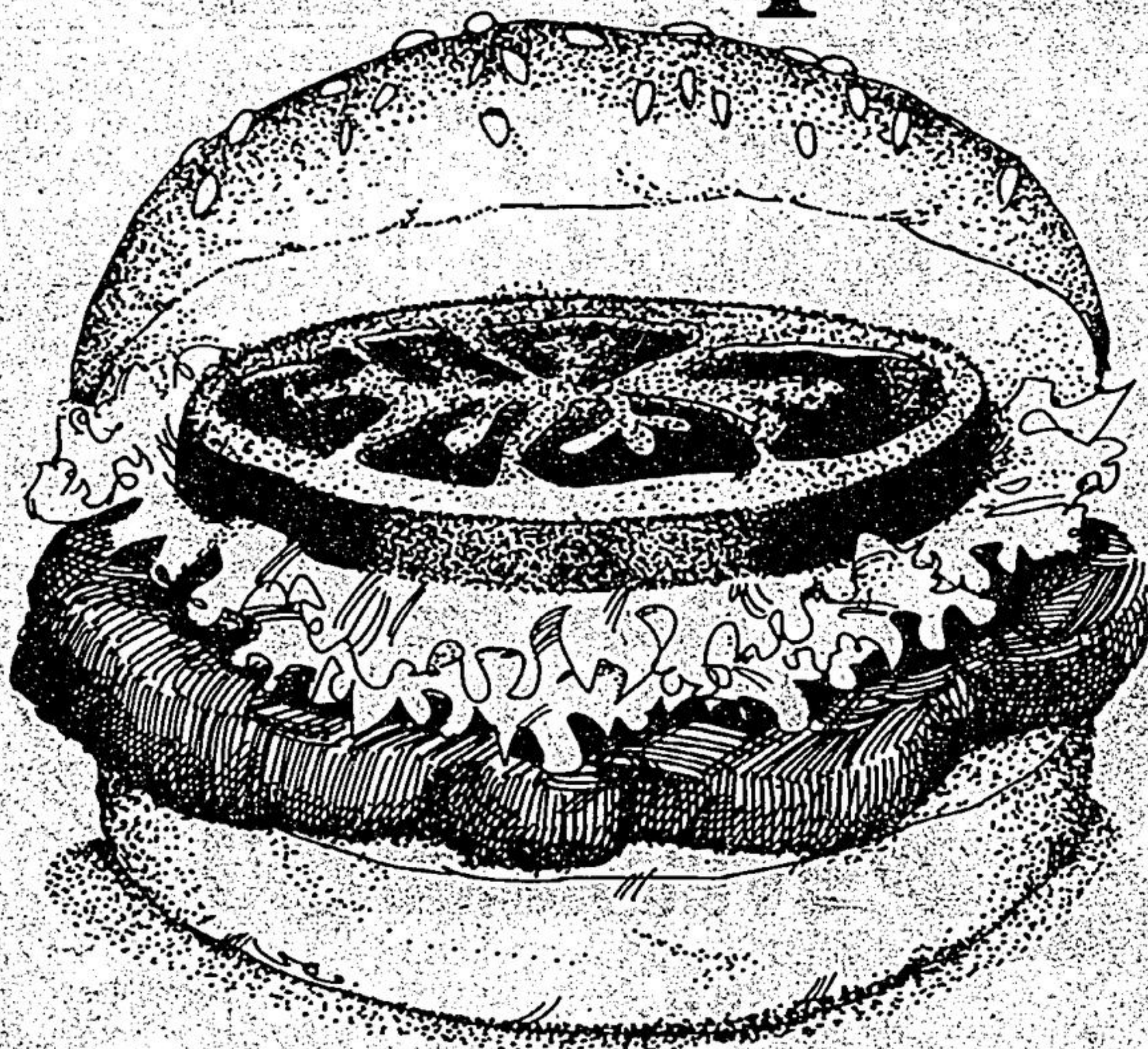
