"Fronske's been with me since Grade 7 (at Summitview Public School)," coach Fletcher said. "He's a great guy; great sense of humor, great spirit, great desire. He is just a pleasure to coach."

Steve's only two points at the final buzzer didn't win the game, but he may have won something just as memorable.

Coach Fletcher promised a Coca-Cola at the beginning of the season to the first member of his team to score an opposite-hand lay-up.
