The competition held at the magnificent Four Glaces Hockey Complex included teams from Ontario, New Brunswick and Newfoundland, along with the Stouffville squad entered in the Bud Light division.

The Clippers reached the semifinals with a record of one win, one tie and one loss, but were defeated 3-2 Sunday morning by the Kincardine Ontario Old Stars.

Hot goaltending and a lack of scoring punch added up to coming out on the wrong end of a 3-2 score. George 'Dooze' Cowley and McKinnon were the Stouffville snipers.

The Clippers had to settle for third place, but as disappointing as it may seem, they were replaced by the memories of a great hockey/holiday weekend.
