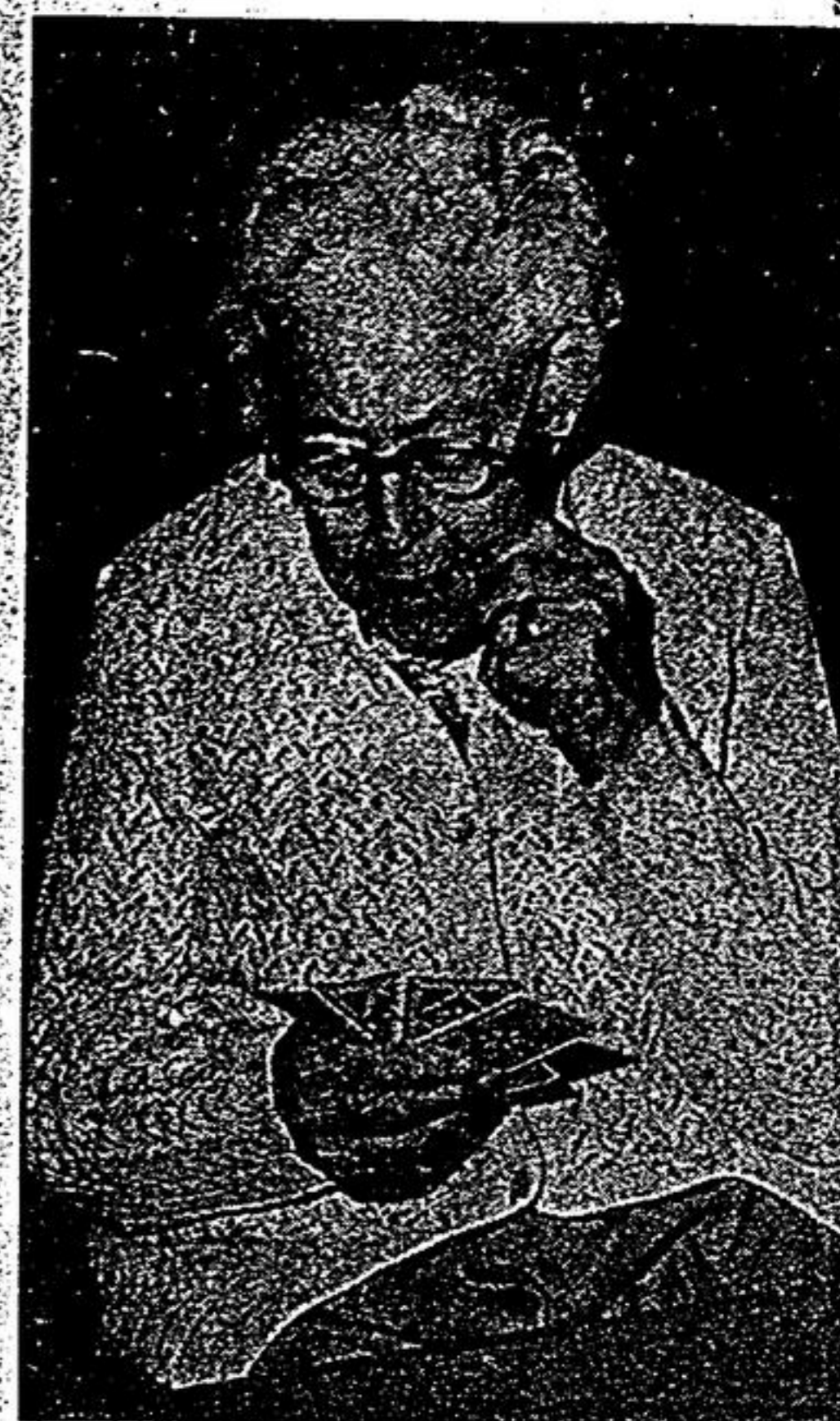

**'The Friendship Club' Organization started thirty-two years ago**

STOUFFVILLE — Webster's Dictionary describes 'friendship' as 'a friendly feeling or atmosphere'.  
Nowhere does this better apply than to the third Thursday evening of each month at the Stouffville Legion Hall.  
The organization's appropriately called 'The Friendship Club'.  
It all started 32 years ago, Marion Murphy, the genial chairper-

son told The Tribune.  
"Actually, the credit should go to Mabel Burkholder, (Elm Road Apartments)," says Marion, "she started it all." The monthly get-togethers remain under the sponsorship of the Legion Ladies Auxiliary.  
The membership fee is two dollars a year.  
In addition to Mrs. Murphy, the committee includes — Marjory Smith, Gladys Clarkson, Ruth Sheppard, Blanche Tindall, Gwen

McFadden and Vera Nesbitt.  
About sixty Seniors belong, Marion explains, and while attendance varies from month to month, it's not unusual for between 40 and 50 to attend.  
The most senior of the Seniors are Lillie Smith and Linda Lehman at ninety plus.  
While different games are preferred, progressive euchre's still the most popular. When Marion toots her whistle, the winners move on. Prizes are awarded at the end of the evening; refreshments too. Gladys (Clarkson) takes care of the food. Marjory (Smith) is the secretary-treasurer.  
Lack of transportation's no excuse. A simple phone call to either Marion or Marjory brings a car to the front door. On a busy night, they begin their rounds at 7 o'clock.  
Most Friendship Club members also belong to the Silver Jubilee Club. Some of the same organizers, including Marion, Marjory and Gladys are involved in both as well.  
The Legion's been very cooperative, Marion says. They provide the hall and heat it at no cost. The Legion Ladies do the rest.  
The executive never changes. It's a foregone conclusion that organizers the year before will carry on the year after. Acclamations are automatic.  
As the name implies, friendship's the secret of success. The memberships' made it this way and keeps it this way. A friendly Senior's the only requirement. Each meets this standard with flying colors.
