

**FIRST AID TIP**



**EMBEDDED OBJECT**  
DO NOT ATTEMPT TO PULL OUT OBJECTS EMBEDDED IN A WOUND. Pulling at nails, splinters, or a piece of glass in a wound will cause more damage and increase bleeding. Cover lightly with dressings without pressure on the object. Secure the padding with bandages to apply pressure around the wound and away from the object. Get medical aid.
