The project was completed in 1962. Mr. Roman was a great admirer of the Victoria Square United Church, in particular the architecture of the chapel. He covered the cost of installing new copper on the roof. He also paved the driveway and contributed sizeable cash donations through the years. He also assisted McVill and Headford

United Church financially. When Pope John visited the Church of the Transfiguration on Woodbine Avenue in 1984, the entire Victoria Square community was invited to a 25 million dollar, edifice stands as a personal memorial. A funeral mass was held from the chapel Saturday afternoon with interment on location. Mr. Roman will be greatly missed.
