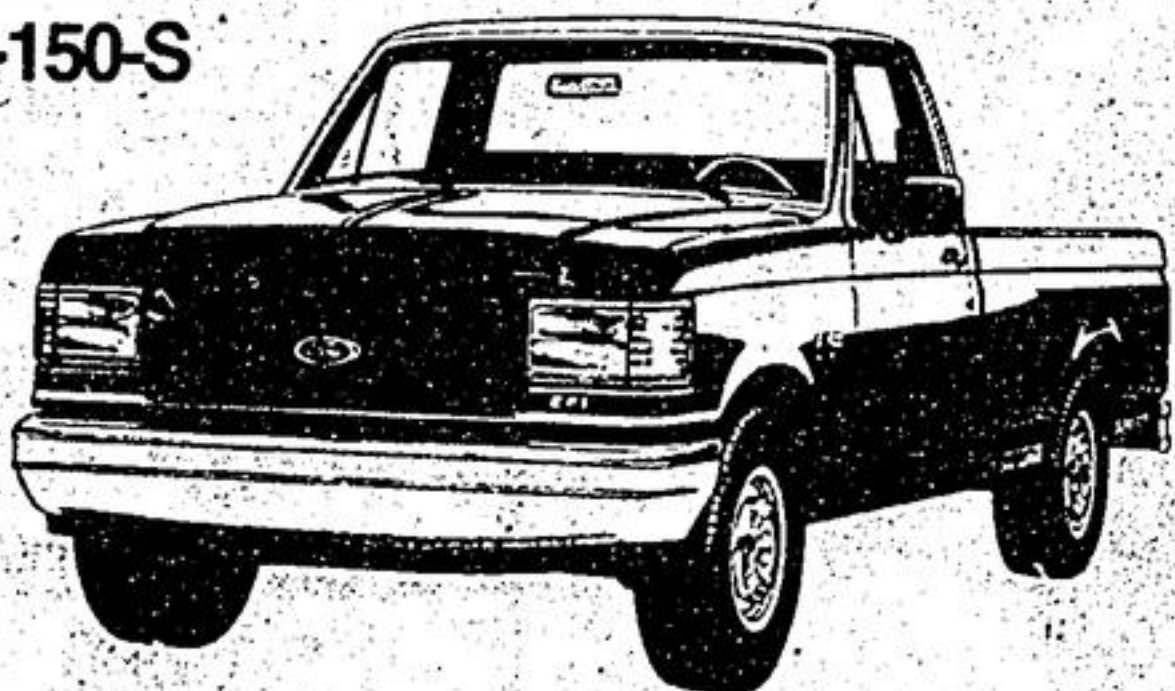

Athlete-scholar

Brains and brawn do mix if you're Brenda Hachey.

The 16-year-old Stouffville Dist. Secondary School student has combined exemplary athletic exploits with an academic average in the mid-80s.

And although her physical stature is hardly brawny, her athletic accomplishment are heavyweight.

Last year the Elm Street resident qualified for the All-Ontario Championships in cross-country, track and field, and soccer. If that's isn't enough how about a silver medal in inter-club figure skating, receiving recognition as Stouffville's 'Female Athlete of the Year' or competing at the national level in field hockey.

Not to shabby for the girl who says she hardly trains and "just does it for fun."

"I don't really train," says the Grade 11 student. "I skate every day after school though."

"I tried training really hard for cross-country last year but the day of the race (All-Ontario Championship) I felt just awful. I didn't feel like running but I was the only one to go on and represent the school. I finished 61st (of 200 runners). The year before I finished 21st. I don't like just training."

And obviously her school marks show it.

A typical day for Brenda is

school, down to the rink, home for dinner then homework.

This summer she hopes to be a member of the under 18 provincial field hockey team. Currently she is practicing once-a-week in Toronto at the Etobicoke Flats.

Her hope is to make the final roster cut. At the moment 30 blue chip players from across Ontario are competing for 18 spots.

Last year Brenda was part of the Ontario under 16 unit. A trip to the National Field Hockey Championship at the University of British Columbia brought back second place honors and plenty of national level experience.

And while field hockey remains her passion, "school comes before everything else" she maintains.

"It's a hobby, I'm not going to be doing this (sports) professionally," she says. "I'm going to university, maybe study english or radio and television directing and producing. I definitely want to get into teaching."

"It (sports) started out as something to do to keep out of my mom's hair," she jokes. "I'm competitive. I'm not just sitting down watching television. It gives me the opportunity to do something creative."

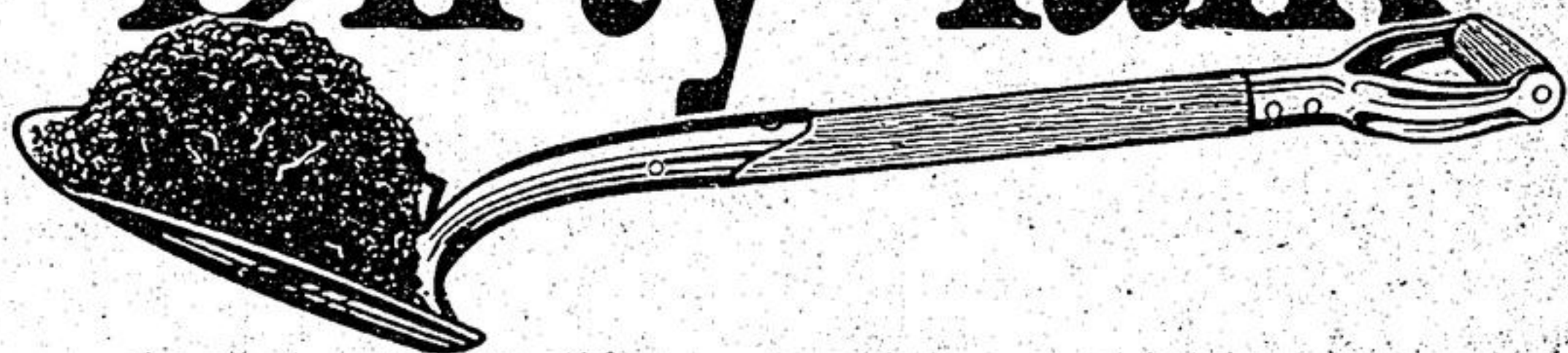
And if there is one person who can take credit for Brenda's 'creativity' it's Terry Fox, the British Columbia native who brought a nation together.



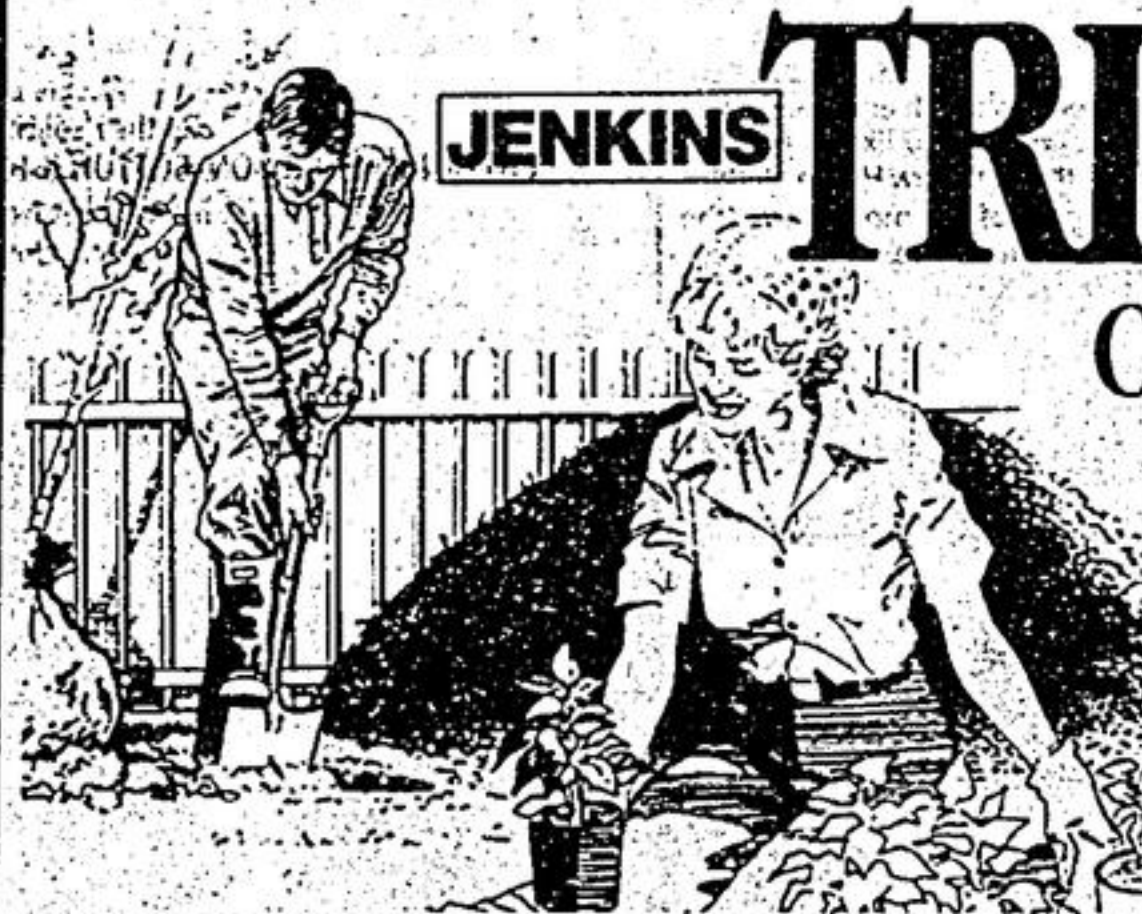
