



NEWS FROM THE LIBRARY

The Town of Markham Public Library Board has approved an increase in adult fines for paperbacks, magazines and pamphlets from \$0.02 to \$0.20 per day, with a \$2.00 maximum per item, effective June 1, 1988. Fines will now be assessed by patron class, rather than by material type. This change will provide necessary uniformity with the computer network (YPLN) of which Markham is a member, speed service to patrons, and cause less confusion. Membership in the network, which provides many benefits for Markham residents, also requires greater uniformity in fine rates around the network. Under the old rates, manual assessment of fines for these items was necessary — anyone who has stood in line waiting for this to be done will appreciate the speed of computer assessed fines, now possible. In addition less confusion will result in a single fine rate for adults and children, than with the previous method of item assessed fines.
