Olean visit a success

 Last week's visit by a band from Olean High School in New York state was a big hit with the visiting students.
 It's the second trip to Stouffville in three years for Dave Johnson, band leader and music teacher from Olean.
 "That first time it took a lot of organizing," Mr. Johnson commented. "It was in the planning stages for several months."
 The plans for this visit were much easier, with Mr. Johnson and Stouffville Dist. Secondary School band leader Peter Samuelson co-ordinating the details.
 Band members stayed at the homes of SDSS students, with Mr. Johnson enjoying the hospitality of Mr. Samuelson and his family.
 "Members of the Stouffville band visited us at the end of April," Mr. Johnson said. "We showed them around the community and the got a chance to find out about our lifestyle."

show for a Stouffville audience. The SDSS group came in for the last few numbers.
 This year's band, with members from Grades 9 to 12, consists of 58 students, about half of whom have never visited Canada before.
 Despite the shortness of their visit — they arrived Tuesday and left Thursday — the Americans managed to fit in some sight-seeing and expressed great enthusiasm for what they had seen.
 "We shopped at the Eaton Centre, played a concert at St. Mark's and wandered around Markville," Mr. Johnson said. A trip to the Ontario Science Centre was also planned.
 Pointing out that Olean was not as economically stable as the Stouffville area, he found the students were particularly impressed with the beautiful homes. They also thought Canadians in general, and Stouffville residents in particular, were very friendly and helpful.
 The exchange is financed mostly through fund-raising activities such as two raffles held by the school.
 "It's good for the kids to get involved," Mr. Johnson claimed.

"It certainly motivates them when it helps to pay for their trip."
 The original idea for the exchange came from a mutual friend of Mr. Samuelson and Mr. Johnson who lives in the Buffalo area. He suggested it to both of them, and a new project was born.
 The Olean School Band started its exchange program 19 years ago, and has travelled through Delaware, Connecticut, Vermont and New Jersey. Stouffville has been its only Canadian venue.
 The band was impressed by the variety of facilities available locally.
 "We are 70 miles south of Buffalo, and you have to travel to Buffalo for almost everything," Mr. Johnson said.
 The Olean band plays a wide variety of music from a medley of Carpenters' hits to Woody Herman standards. The closing number at the school concert was *We Are The World*.
 Mr. Johnson is said he believes the exchange program has great benefits for everyone involved.
 "This is a very healthy thing to do," he declared. "The kids learn a lot from these trips which more than makes up for the time they miss in class."
