The domestic hen, fostering the 19 poult, immediately launched

herself at the intruder. The weasel, however, paid the hen little heed as it darted around her and added a second pheasant to its casualty list.

This confusion of feathers, litter, and fleeing pheasants had all

the makings of a massacre. In fact the blood thirsty killer was so intent on carrying out its deadly mission it seemed oblivious to my presence.

As it dashed into the terrified flock to claim yet another victim, I swung the stick and knocked the culprit sideways. The mother hen, frustrated in her previous attempts to come to grips with the elusive brown predator, now landed on the downed weasel.

Her attack, however, was one of futile revenge for the weasel was already dead.

As I refilled the upturned feed

troughs and picked up the carcasses to leave, my thoughts drifted to other predator losses we suffered in the past.

Several years ago, seven year-old turkeys were killed on Labor Day weekend, thanks to a family of foxes; while a mink victimized 21 chickens last fall in a one-night orgy.

A year ago, a pair of skunks took three of our breeding pheasants and later that summer a couple of raccoons broke through the loft of the small barn and cleaned out 11 more.

Actually, there have been many other single and multiple

casualties among our poultry since we revitalized the old farm nearly nine years ago.






