UXBRIDGE — An area man has been fined a total of \$40,000 on pollution charges.

Norman Clements, R.R. 1 Uxbridge, was found guilty June 6 at Provincial Court in Ajax on two counts of illegal waste disposal.

He was charged with using land that is not a waste disposal site and depositing waste on land that is not a waste disposal site for the period March 4 to March 26, 1987. Each count entails a \$20,000 fine.
