MUSSELMAN'S LAKE — Residents of O'Connor Drive, Musselman's Lake are upset over the parking of dump trucks and tractor-trailers on their street.

A petition, signed by all but four property-owners, has been received by the Town.

Reasons given include — unsightliness, noise, road damage, vision obstruction "and generally the lack to conform with the use of Connor Drive being a residential neighborhood."

The petition also claims such parked vehicles lower the value of property and the standard of living.

Residents have asked a bylaw be passed prohibiting the practice.
