CONSUMER ALERT

Soft Without Salt? Don't Believe It!

The Canadian Water Quality Association warns consumers to be wary of water softening claims regarding No Salt Softeners which use magnetic devices or devices which pass water over an alloy. The Federal Department of Justice has recently laid 23 charges concerning No Salt Softeners under Section 36(1)(b) of the Competition Act.

Tests performed on water samples taken before and after passing through such devices conclusively demonstrate that they do not remove or neutralize hardness minerals (calcium and magnesium) or provide the traditional benefits of soft water as claimed.

Hard water contains calcium and magnesium which react negatively with soap to produce a curd which hinders the cleaning process.

Traditional softeners remove calcium and magnesium by passing water through ion exchange resin, which requires periodic regeneration using salt. The result is water that enhances the cleaning process by reacting positively with soap to produce a rich lather of suds.
