False testimony

MARKHAM — A 25-year-old woman has admitted she made up a story that resulted in charges being laid against a Markham man that had him placed in jail eight days. Susan Brooks testified she was drunk on the night of the alleged incident and lied to police. Charges, filed against Russell Craig Fenn, 31, of Markham, have been dismissed or withdrawn. The incident dates back to June 7, 1987. At the time, Brooks said Fenn threw in a bonfire, cut her with a knife and threatened both her and their five-month-old baby with a knife. Later, the complainant admitted she tried to take the baby away from Fenn but he told her she was too drunk to take care of it. Bitter over the arrest, Fenn said his Markham antique and storage business had suffered from adverse publicity. He claimed he had no opportunity to defend himself and that everything said by Brooks was accepted as fact.

Barbecue

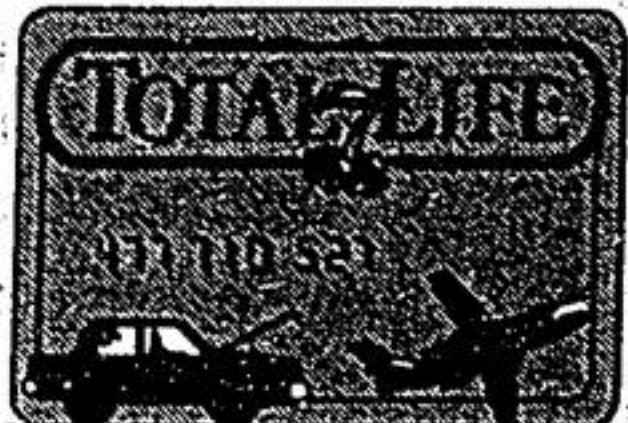
