STOUFFVILLE — It was back in the late 30s that Adin Annable travelled to England for a vacation. The holiday extended from six weeks into eighteen years. For it was there she met Don Ward. The two were playing tennis at the time.

"We were doubled up so decided to make it permanent," Don says with a smile.

Don and Adin were married Aug. 5, 1938. Their honeymoon was spent on the Isle of Wight.

It wasn't their intent to remain in England so long. However, an event in history called World War II interrupted their plans.

Mr. Ward, a firefighter, was one of England's most valuable civil servants, particularly at the height of German blitz. Mrs. Ward was a member of the Women's Voluntary Service.

As frightening as those days were, they're but distant memories in the lives of couple who, on Saturday, celebrated their Golden Wedding Anniversary.

An 'Open House' was enjoyed at the home of their daughter and son-in-law, Karen and Jim Rowsell, 72 Tilman Circle, Markham.

Close to 100 people attended. Don and Adin are proud of their family that also includes three sons, Robin of Newmarket, Martin in Stratford, Glenn at Glasgow and six grandchildren. All were present at Saturday's reunion.

Mr. Ward has a sister, Myrtle Wiseman in Cornwall, England. Mrs. Ward has three sisters, Vega in Newmarket; Rede in Exeter, England; Ruth at Markham and a brother Henry near Unionville.

Don and Adin lived at Willowdale after leaving England in 1948. Later, they resided on the Aurora Sideroad,

then moved to Ashmount Farm, McCowan Road. They now reside at 366 Glad Park Avenue, Stouffville.

Mrs. Ward, an extremely talented lady, has many hobbies. These include sewing and rug-hooking. Her artistic skills are amazing with many beautiful paintings located about their home. She also enjoys her garden.

A pleasant lady, she continually refers to her children and grandchildren, subjects of close affection.

Mr. Ward shares his wife's interests. As a younger man, he was the light heavyweight weight-lifting champion of England. He has a framed plaque as proof of his strength and skill.

While the war years spent in England are firmly etched in

their minds, Don and Adin escaped injury despite some close calls.

"One bomb landed right around the corner," Mrs. Ward remembers, "too close for comfort."

Mr. Ward recalls Winston Churchill as "the man of the hour."

They've been back to England a couple of times "but everything's changed," they agree.

They've also travelled West on two occasions and hope to return again.

While many memories remain, Saturday's anniversary gathering was an event they'll never forget. For Don and Adin, being in the company of family friends and relatives is a celebration in itself.
