

New store is a bright addition to Stouffville

George Perez-Salas wants to light up Stouffville.

He's the manager of Stouffville's newest business, The Mount Lighting, which opened Saturday in Stouffville Place Mall, Main Street West.

The Oshawa resident is one of three partners who own the store. The other two are Candido Ferrera, of Holland Landing and Rob Luchinger, of Oshawa.

Ferrera has a store in Newmarket, and was looking to expand.

"We discussed going into business together, and I said go for it, it's now or never," Perez-Salas explains. "I guess this is something we all dream about —

to have our own business."

He believes a lighting store will be successful in Stouffville.

There aren't any others in town, and he notes that he's received nothing but favorable comments from passersby.

"People have come by and said, 'Oh, I need a lamp like this,'" he says. "It sounds good so far."

The business will offer all kinds of lighting, including chandeliers, table lamps, floor lamps, wall lamps and outdoor fixtures.

"This was the only store in the mall that wasn't equipped with lights," Perez-Salas points out. "But it sure is the brightest one now," he laughs.

Perez-Salas says he'll also have a fixture custom-made if requested.

"If you want a particular style that we don't have in the store, we can get the parts," he explains. "We're very flexible. For example, if you want a particular chandelier, but with a different number of lights, we'll likely be able to do it."

Perez-Salas says his inventory will be mostly in a medium price range.

"But we will have merchandise at both ends. There will be a few low-priced items and some fancy stuff."

The Mount Lighting is open at 9:30 a.m. and closes at 9 p.m. weekdays and 6 p.m. Saturdays.
