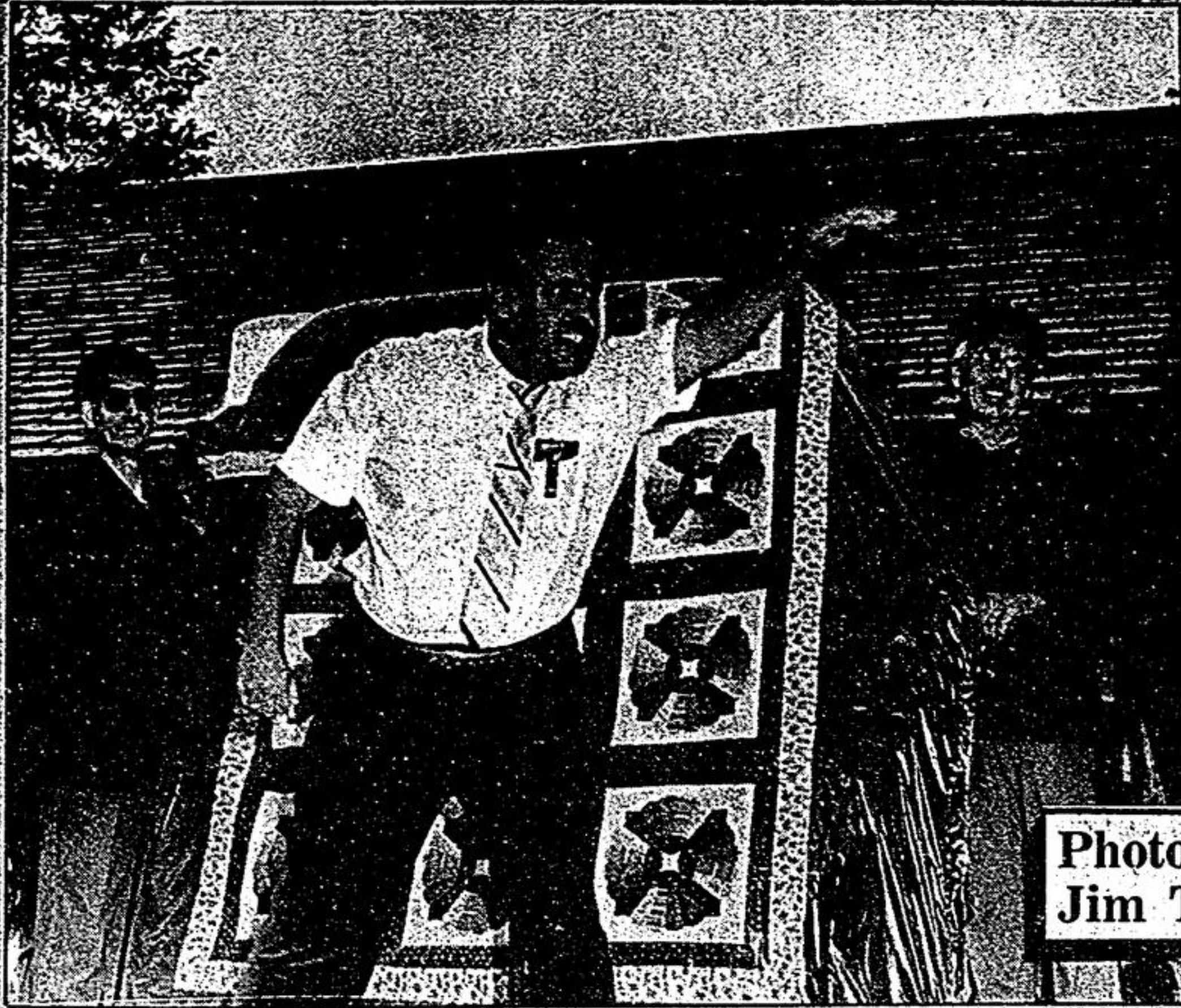


# Mennonite Festival a success
