

Town's left-hand turn light an aid to many motorists

Mr. Lundman, in his letter to Council, points to the problems created by the left-hand turn signal at Ninth Line North and Main Street, Stouffville. His observations are correct. I wonder, however, if the writer had previously observed the problems motorists were hav-

ing in making the turn before the signal was installed. If two drivers got through on the amber they were lucky. Many were taking the 'bypass' via Westlawn Crescent and Rupert Avenue. As so often occurs, the Town solves one problem and creates

another. So what if traffic is backed up on Main Street on a Saturday? So what if traffic is backed up on week-day mornings? There are bypass roads around Stouffville, (Bloomington Road, Bethesda Sideroad, 19th Avenue, Markham, etc.), so let motorists

take them if they don't want to wait. Left-hand turn signals aren't all that unusual, even in areas busier than Stouffville. Sincerely,

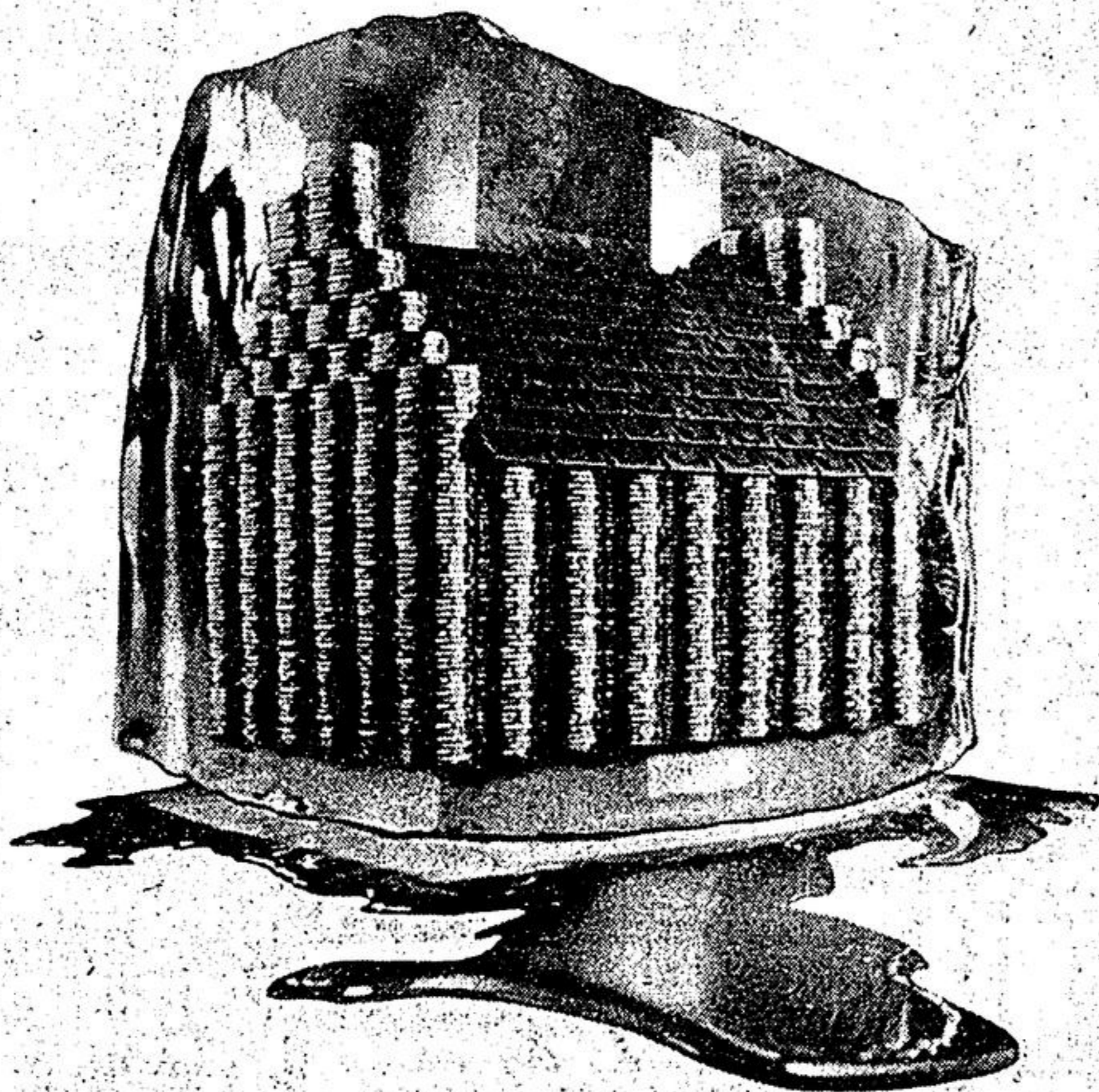

Heart Fund skips to the beat of the jump rope

Dear Editor:
"Jump-Rope-For-Heart" was a skipping success in 1987-88. Forty-eight schools in Durham Region participated last year in this unique school fitness program offered by the Heart & Stroke Foundation of Ontario.

These students, along with young people in schools from Big Trout Lake in Northern Ontario to a Canadian Forces base school in West Germany, spent last year learning the importance of physical activity while also raising funds for the Heart Foundation.

Through two-hour jump event fund-raisers, the students collected pledges and raised \$2.58 million to help fund ongoing research and education programs into heart disease and stroke, Canada's No. 1 killer.

Approximately 40 percent of the province's schools have taken part in Jump-Rope-For-Heart since it was introduced in 1982 to

324 schools. Last year, 1713 schools participated.
