## Betz squad falls to 3rd in tourney

Despite the heroics of slugger Gary Vaughan, the Stouffville Betz Pools Men's Fastball team was forced to settle for a third place finish in the Oshawa City and District fastball League playoff tournament in Port Perry over the weekend.

The big first baseman belted four home runs in four games, accounting for half the entire Betz offence.

And with a few breaks, the Stouffville squad might have won the whole ball of wax.

The team lost its opening encounter 3-2 to Oshawa ACL. Vaughan's two-run homer in the 6th inning drove home Mark Fockler who had tripled. Jim Chilvers fanned 10 in a losing cause.

But in game two, John Annis hurled a gritty three-hitter and doubled; home the game's only run as the Poolmen took a 1-0 win over the Oshawa MCL Juniors. Stouffville then stunned the host Port Perry team 7-3 with Chilvers tossing a four-hitter. Vaughan cracked two home runs with team captain Mark Fockler adding a three-run shot of his own and Chilvers managing a two-run blast.

Vaughan started the ball rolling against Greebank clobbering

a two-run homer in the first inning of game four. However Greenbank came back to take a 3-2 win.

Annis was effective once again holding his opponents to five hits while striking out eight.

Team sponsor Marvin Betz said he is satisfied with the season despite what could be considered a so-so campaign.

"The guys gave it their best shot," he said. "We're not going to win the OASA (Ontario) championship every year."

The Betz squad won the provincial title in its first year of operation and took the league crown in 1987.
