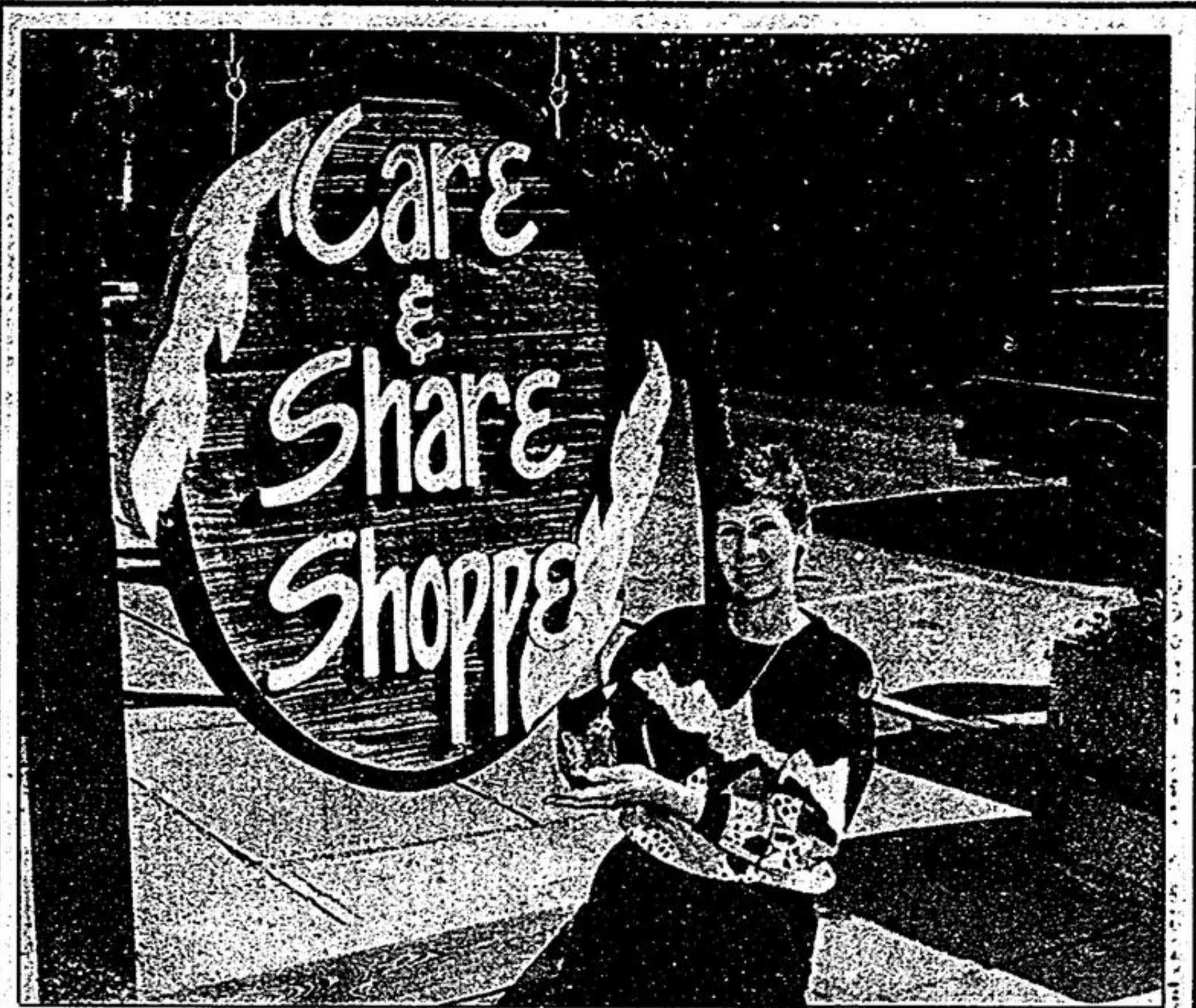

**Farm severance  
thorny problem**

WHITCHURCH — On Oct. 18, a severance application by Neil and Margaret Conner, Hwy. 48, R.R. 2, Stouffville, came before the Town's Planning Advisory Committee.

The request resulted in lengthy discussion.

Mayor Fran Sainsbury urged approval. The Conner family, she said, have been long-time residents of the community. Much of their land, she suggested, is not suitable for farming. She further claimed a single severance would be more acceptable than a plan of subdivision.

Councillors Wayne Emmerson and Jim Sanders were less enthusiastic. Emmerson pointed to

a 50-year regulation with respect to agricultural severances. He feared approval of this application could set a precedent and others would soon follow.

Sanders suggested the Committee take no position rather than go against the recommendations of Planner Michael Saunders.

Mr. Saunders urged the Town to co-operate with the Ministry of Agriculture re the 50-year limit rather than "jump the gun and upset them."

Members finally agreed with Councillor Sanders' suggestion that no position be taken and the Land Division Committee be so informed.
