Social reforms, that have been adopted by most of the industrialized nations over the last 75 years, have been the result of continuous pressure from outside and within Parliaments from those groups and individuals who wished for a better life for the underprivileged, the end result

being the formation of Socialist parties within the democratic parliamentary systems of the western world.

At election time, in many cases, other parties have adopted the ideas of Left Wing Parties and made them planks in their own platforms, claiming them to be results of their own "think tanks".

If it hadn't been for Socialist thinking, I doubt many of the benefits we enjoy in the Social field would be in force today.

People who link Socialism with Communism, obviously haven't lived in a Communist country.

Just as dangerous as Communist thought is the thinking of such radical right wing people as Senator McCarthy was in the United States many years ago where he and his like saw a 'Commie' under every bed of 'suspected' people. Many had their careers shattered by being

However, in trying to implement their philosophy through parliamentary means, it often becomes bogged down with an overload of bureaucracy and a large unproductive civil service that tends to stifle its own well-meaning philosophy.
