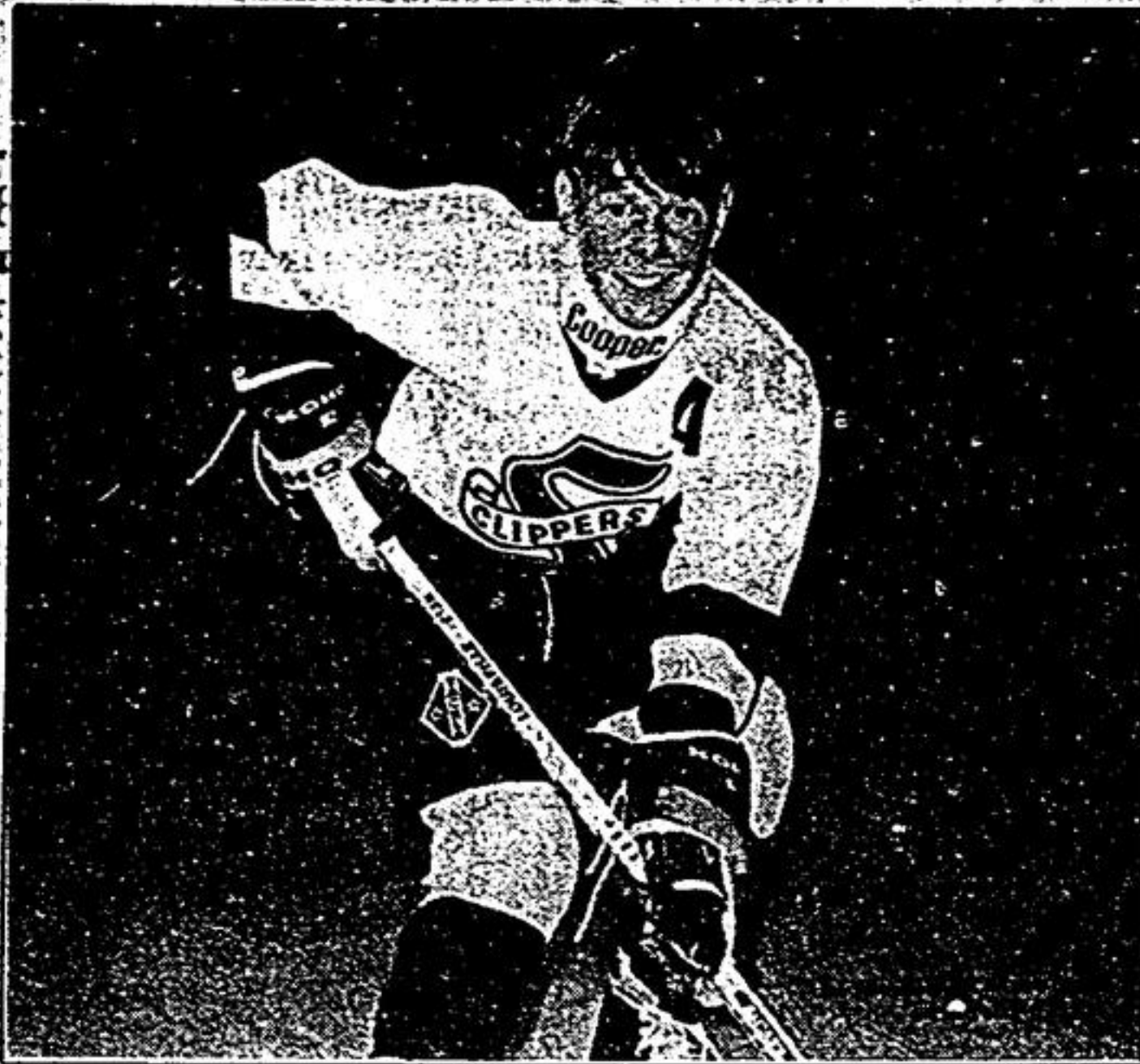


Against Port Perry Stouffville Atoms squeak by with 3-2 win

SAVES THE DAY: Brent Avery, of the Stouffville Atom Clippers did a great deal to help his team eke out a 3-2 win against Port Perry last week. Avery set up the tying goal, and scored the winner late in the contest.

The Stouffville Atom Clippers played with fire last Friday night at the Recreation Centre, but somehow managed to keep from getting burned.

The Fame International Clippers took eight of the game's nine penalties, but still came out on the long end of a 3-2 score against Port Perry.

Held in the game in the early going by the catching glove of netminder Brad Hackert, the Stouffville squad capitalized on their only power play opportunity of the game to take a 1-0 lead into the second frame.

Graham Crowder fed defenceman Ian Ellis at the point, who then fired the puck. Steve Wilcox was there to stuff it

between the Port Perry goalie's legs.

The visitors tied matters in the second period, and went ahead early in the third.

But Brent Avery went to work, setting up Mike Underwood to tie it up with a little more than seven minutes to play, then fired the winner from Roger McMann a minute and 40 seconds later.

Port Perry pulled their goalie with less than a minute to go, but failed to exert significant pressure on Hackert.

The Atoms saw their four-game winning streak come to a halt on Sunday, however, bowing 6-2 to Bowmanville on the road.

The Bulls scored four times before the Clippers could regroup. John McKinnon finally

put the Clippers on the board late in the first period, with an assist from Mike Underwood.

Stouffville failed to capitalize on numerous chances in the second stanza, and Chad Dickenson's marker in the third was too little, too late.

The Atoms play at Cobourg this Friday, then come back to the Recreation Centre to host Port Hope on Nov. 9 at 7 p.m.

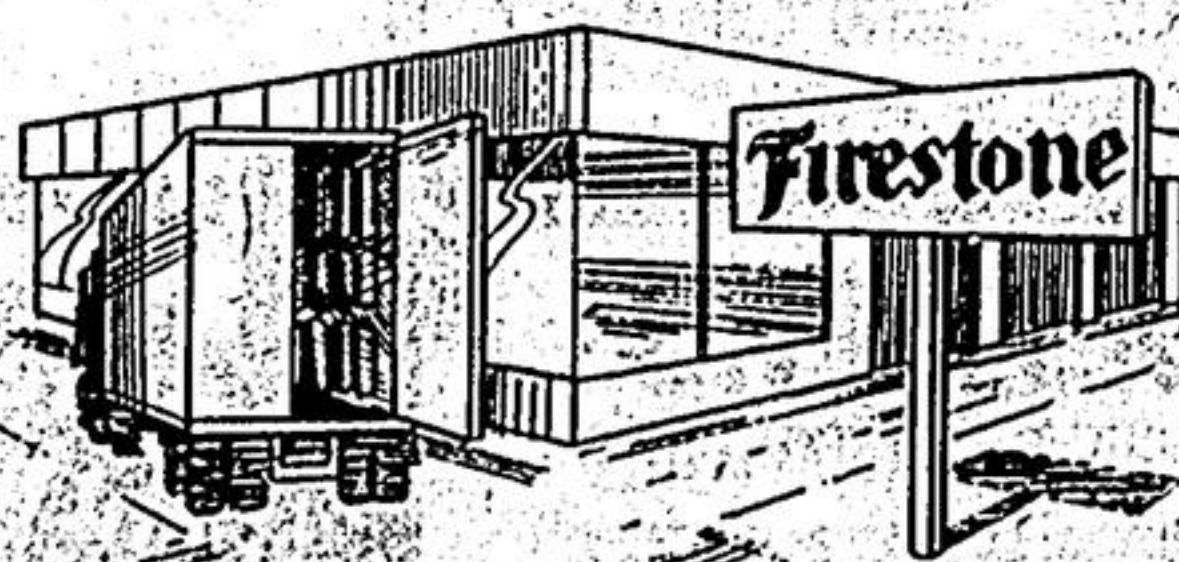
