

# Pickering hopeful tries again

timistic. "Both my grandfathers worked for John Diefenbaker and he lost his first six elections," he says.

The 16-year Pickering resident who is running for Council in Ward 3 has failed in three attempts to capture the Ward 3 position or a spot on Regional Council.

Johnson, 34, has an entrepreneurial background which he feels will make him a valuable addition to Pickering town council.

But he remains ever optimistic.

He was the largest independent cattle dealer in Ontario at age 33, and is now president of an agency

that consults for and co-ordinates entertainment for fairs, service clubs and special functions.

He is also a full-time entertainer who sings country music.

"I'm an entrepreneur. I want to put the business approach back into Pickering politics. There's no one on council now with a business background."

Johnson wants to see more recycling, especially in the north of the town, as well as an upgrading of roads. He also favors an upgrading of parks and recreation facilities in his ward.

He is aware of the inevitability of development, but wants to make sure proper green spaces are maintained as development occurs.

And, like other candidates, he is concerned about the mounting garbage crisis.

"We don't want any more dumps in Pickering," he says. "But we need to work with the Toronto people to find a solution to the Toronto and Pickering garbage situation. We must find a suitable waste management program that is feasible for us and that is safe for the environment."

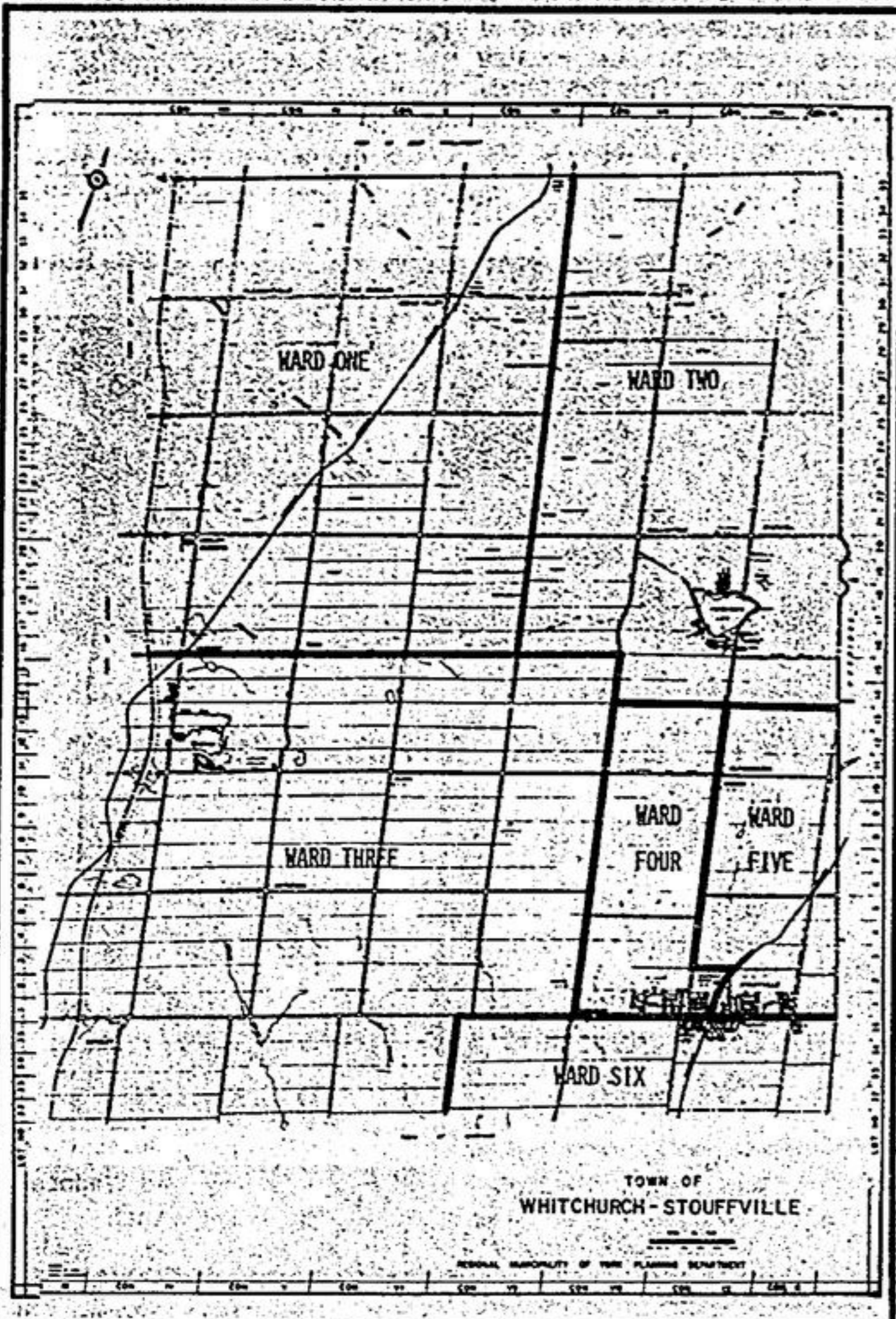
Johnson would like to see the encouragement of business and industry in designated areas to ease the tax burden. He sees the need for a more co-ordinated traffic management program to reduce undesirable traffic through residential areas.

And he feels there should be a more effective system of scrutinizing satisfactory completion of homes by developers.

"Everything is concentrated in the south end of the town, around the 401," he claims. "I'd like to see a new hockey arena or a recreation complex built in the central part of the town."
