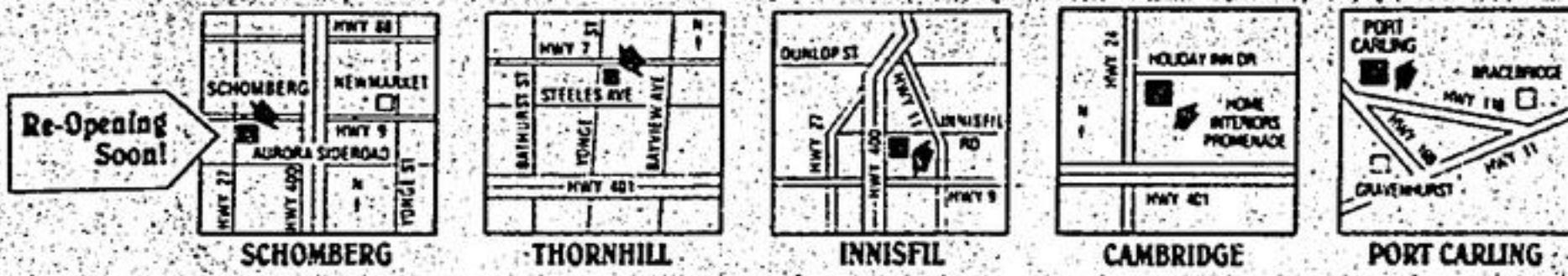

Take notice that an application to amend the Parkway Belt Land Use Regulation filed as Ontario Regulation 473/73 in the Town of Markham has been received. The details of the application are:
