

Penalty-laden game

Bantams clip Bowmanville 1-0

For Stouffville Bantam Clipper coach Terry Lamb and most of his players, it was a case of high emotion clouding better judgement.

But for Clipper defenceman Eilert Fraser, it was an opportunity to demonstrate restraint in the midst of adversity.

The end result was a not-so-pretty 1-0 victory over Bowmanville in a game where Fraser's self-control and solid play at the Stouffville blueline provided the contest's sole example of artistry.

Clipper goaltender Shawn Wilson completed several key saves. And Stouffville defenceman Bill Pride was the only player on either club to dent the twine.

The game featured a parade of penalties. Both teams were forced to play two men short on a number of occasions.

In a previous meeting between the two clubs, a bench-clearing brawl resulted. Remembering this, the contest was expected to be scrappy.

That game was won by Stouffville 2-1.

Thirty-one penalties were called in the first and second periods, 19 going to Stouffville. Thanks to the control maintained by referee Glen Gaudet, a repeat of the earlier 'mob scene' was avoided. Stouffville's Dave Showers was the only player ejected from the

delivered with reckless abandon and bodies were flying everywhere. Clutch-and-grab was the order of the night.

Bill Pride's game-winner came on a slap-shot from the right point during a second period power play. Franco Santeramo and Clayton King drew assists.

While referee Gaudet spent much of the night skating to and from the timekeeper's box, he admitted to being impressed with Fraser's play.

"That No. 4 was a rock out there," he said. "He kept his stick on the ice the whole time even though everyone around him was getting into it."

Coach Lamb felt his team had done well to survive the numerous power-play opportunities provided the visitors.

"They played well. Wilson made some big saves. Fraser was great and Kevin Nicholls

won most of the faceoffs in our end," he said.

But he was the first to admit to his own over-zealousness in the contest.

"I was hoping to be more low key this season," he concluded.
