Honey Comb Donuts has already become a favorite place for friends to meet for coffee and a chat; Kellington's is popular with teens and families, and Stouffville Fish & Chips offers a tasty family meal in pleasant surroundings, as well as an excellent take out service.

Music fans will find a good selection of records, CDs and tapes and video tape rentals at Wheels. The three clothing stores range from the relaxed informality of Rhythm & Blues to casual elegance at Leona Lynns Fashions; with The Dapper Man offering a selection of men's wear including suits and leather jackets, as well as accessories such as ties and belts.

The recent arrival of Electronics & More and House of Linen should encourage more people to do their Christmas shopping locally.

If you're working on home improvements, the Mount Lighting has some very attractive fixtures on display, including beautifully decorated porcelain lamps; Ontario Sun-Drape Inc. is the place to shop for a complete range of window coverings.

The Smoke and Gift sells a good variety of cards, magazines, party accessories and many other items. The deli counter at McKee Fine Foods features meats, pates, and cheeses, as well as chips, pop and a wide range of ice cream flavors.

Flowers, plants and balloons welcome you into Monaco Florist, while those hoping to strike it rich can try their luck at Loto Place. At the east end sits the granddaddy of them all, Card's Hardware, which has all kinds of hidden treasures, along with standard items, as well as some very attractive giftware.

Vincent's Shoes, near the main entrance, often features excellent bargains. If you want to put your feet up and be pampered, try Quality Hair Cutters, which offers total family hair care at reasonable prices; or get yourself into shape for Christmas by visiting Body Trim in the lower level of the mall.
