## Greystone Homes are ready to roll

Construction of the Summerfield Park Subdivision on the north side of Main Street West, will commence as soon as necessary permits are issued, according to a representative for Greystone Homes.

"We'd like to move people in next spring," David Brand of David Brand Real Estate told The Tribune.

While a portion of the designated land is swampy, it will have no affect on residential

properties, Mr. Brand explained. The marshy land is in the industrial and commercial area. This will be entirely removed and replaced by clean fill, he said.

No final decisions have been made with regard to what stores will occupy the shopping area.

"At this time, it's still in the design stage," he stated, "we've made no definite decisions."

Construction will continue throughout the winter months, Mr. Brand said, with outdoor work taking place under tents.

Once buildings have been constructed, they'll be heated.

A total of 52 homes are planned in two phases. Forty-two of these have been registered.

Greystone Homes recently completed a residential development on the south-east corner of Hwy. 7 and Kennedy Road, Markham, also one in Richmond Hill. Another subdivision is planned in Georgina, Mr. Brand said. The houses here will be fully bricked and range in size from 2,226 to 2,770 square feet.
