

Lloyd sang in gospel quartet

CLAREMONT — The sanctuary of Claremont United Church was filled to overflowing Nov. 19, as folk from far and near paid their respects to the memory of a close friend.

Lloyd MacGregor died Nov. 12 in Uxbridge Cottage Hospital following an illness of more than five years. He was 65.

Lloyd was born in Uxbridge, Ont., son of William and Olive (Ashton) MacGregor. Following their marriage, Lloyd and Lillian (Redshaw)

lived at Brougham for 11 years and 27 years at Claremont. Lloyd was employed for a time at John's Manville and later Scogg Lumber. He was a skilled carpenter.

Lloyd enjoyed softball and bowling. He was one of the best dart players in the village.

Lloyd was a member of the well-known Quaker Hill Male Quartet. For a period of 14 years, they sang at special church services locally as well as in Toronto, Oshawa and Bobcaygeon. The three

surviving members, Ron Duckworth, Don Pelletier and Orv Brethour, served as pallbearers.

Other pallbearers included Don Kane, Bill Ball and Clarence Beelby.

Mr. Brethour recalled those happy days when the boys would sit at a table wherever there was a piano.

The group originated out of Quaker Hill Presbyterian Church back in 1912, he said. When a baritone member had

to leave, Lloyd filled his place.

Lloyd was one of the best baritone quartet singers I ever heard, Orv recalled.

During the funeral service, the congregation listened in silence as an original quartet tape entitled Home of the Soul was played.

Lloyd had a solo part. "It sure brought back a lot of memories," Mr. Brethour said.

Lloyd was close to his family — wife Lillian, daughters

Brenda, Frantz (Hawaii) and Kathy (deceased); one son, Kevin of Baldwin; two granddaughters, Jessica and Joshua MacGregor; and two sisters, Joyce Taylor of Uxbridge and Elva (deceased).

Rev. Louise Berry, a close friend of the family spoke of the respect held for Lloyd in the Claremont community and beyond. The filled sanctuary was silent testimony to this fact. Interment was made at Claremont Cemetery.
