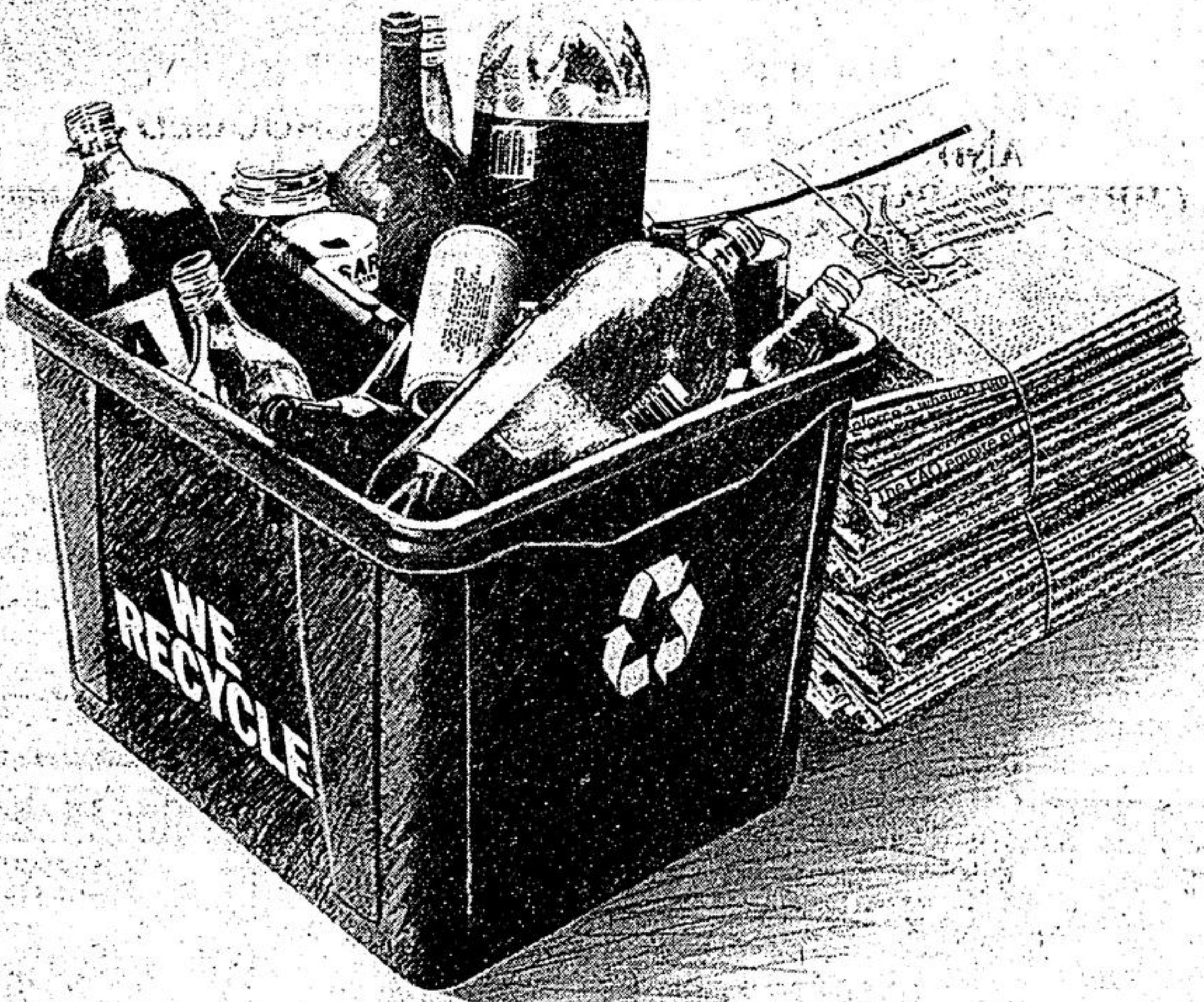

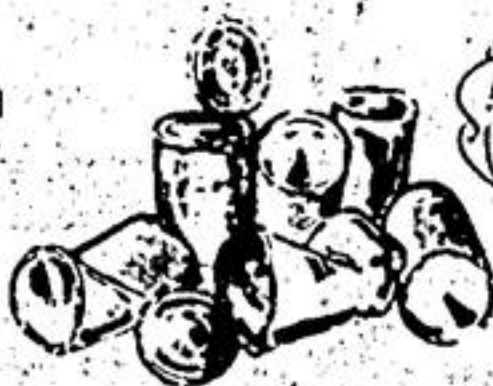
You can be part of it. Simply collect and store newspapers, glass bottles and jars, beverage and food cans and plastic soft drink containers in your Blue Box.

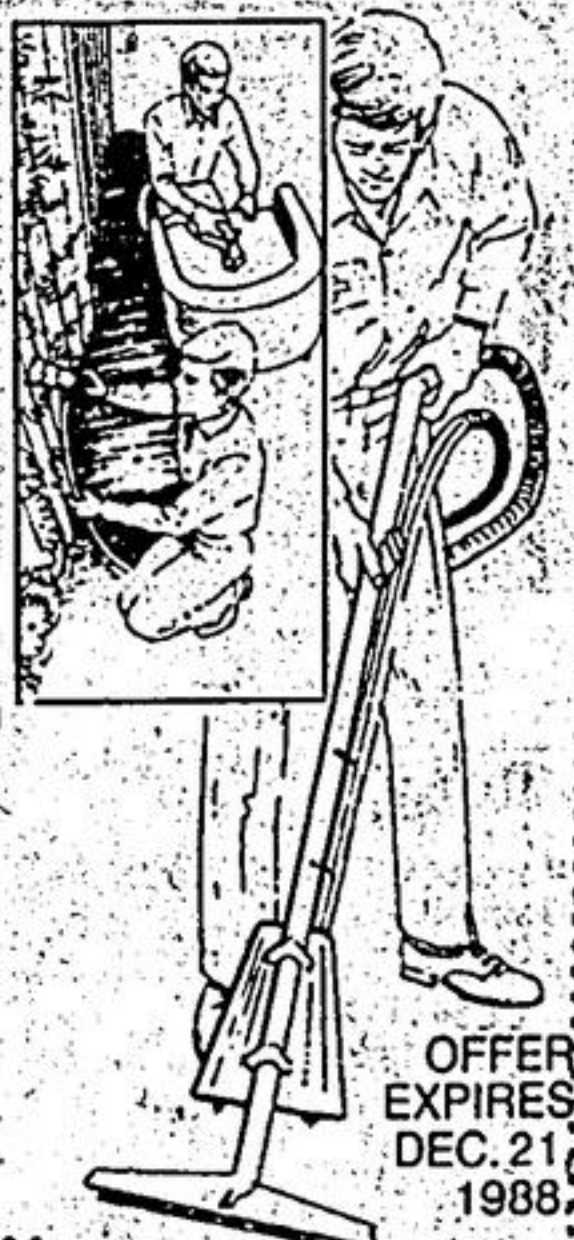
