

Jannetta at Deer Park Saturday

Young New Year's Eve celebrants at Stouffville's Deer Park Inn will have a special treat this year. From 10 p.m. to midnight, they will be entertained by Jannetta.

Jannetta is a bright young recording artist from Toronto who has appeared in all kinds of shows and has performed at the Canadian National Exhibition and at Toronto's Imperial Room.

She has represented Canada at Europe's oldest song festival, Sopot, which is held annually in Poland, and where she earned the title Favorite of Musicians.

Her album, *Breathless*, was released earlier this year. This album, which has a strong dance influence, features nine recordings, seven of which were co-written by Jannetta.

Her touring schedule last summer included Summerside, Halifax, Montreal, Toronto, Thunder Bay, Winnipeg, Calgary, Edmonton and Vancouver.

The tour was supported by Adams Brands, manufacturers of Certs breath mints. After hearing the initial tracks from the album *Breathless*, the Adams people decided to commit an investment of what was described as "an unprecedented amount of money" to a national promotion built around the young singer. Her appeal is targeted at the age 15 to 24 market.
