Novice Clippers win playoff series

In a game that had all the drama and excitement of a Stanley Cup final, the Stouffville Novice Clippers edged Bowmanville 2-1 at the Recreation Centre Friday night to capture the best-of-five playoff series.

The first-round playoff win came when Grahame Smith scored with two minutes and 42 seconds left in the third period. Until then, it was beginning to look like there would be overtime for the third time in the series.

The Neil Patrick Clippers had captured game one 8-4, lost game three 2-1 and tied two others in which an extra 10-minute period had failed to produce a winner.

In Friday's finale, Bowmanville scored on the first shift of the game to take a 1-0 lead. But then Clippers goalie Jason Brown shut the Bulls down entirely the rest of the way.

Robbie Spytz tied it up from Andrew Hutchinson just one minute after the visitors' goal was netted and then the two teams played scoreless hockey until Smith potted his series winner with an assist from Ryan King.

Smith's goal came just after the Clippers had a goal called back due to a Bowmanville

player being injured just before it was scored, causing the referee to whistle the play dead.

Clippers' coach Dave Turner admitted he was biting his nails the final few minutes.

"It was a tense two minutes

and 42 seconds after that."

The coach felt his troops had earned their victory. "The boys stuck to their game plan."

Turner singled out his defence corps as the heroes in the big win. "Jeff Hassard, Grahame Smith,

Andrew Hutchinson and Shawn Carruthers were just super on defence."

The Novices will now play the winner of the Port Perry-Cobourg playoff for the league championship.
