

Residents protest Some trees must go councillor certain

STOUFFVILLE — Although the removal of a considerable number of mature trees in the town of Stouffville has been temporarily averted, ward six councillor Jim Sanders cautions that some will probably face the axe in the near future.

Public awareness on the issue surfaced when residents of O'Brien Avenue discovered that a number of the trees on the street were scheduled to be cut

down as the result of a survey by Richmond Hill Tree Service. The residents learned that the work was to have been carried out in a matter of days.

"The engineer is going to look at them again; we have to stop and look at them to see what we can do to save them," commented Councillor Sanders. To avoid such situations in future, he said, a proper tree maintenance program should be set up, to include the planting of new trees to replace those that are dying or

that pose a safety hazard.

"I hope that will be the outcome of this; to show everybody the importance of getting it (the program) in place. A lot of trees were in really bad shape; we should have looked after them long ago and done a better job of it." Even with such a program, Councillor Sanders pointed out, there will always be some trees that will have to be cut down.

He is confident that not all the trees slated for the axe will have to go, and he's not sure how the situation occurred in the first place. "There was no money in the budget to do anything anyway. I don't know how they would have paid them (Richmond Hill Tree Service)."

The tree committee, which has been set up to advise council on tree maintenance, will work with a select committee of technical people, including engineering coordinator Paul Whitehouse, to present recommendations to the town.

The committee has an important role to play, declared Councillor Sanders, "because trees are a major resource to the town and to have these people looking at them and caring for them will help to protect that resource."

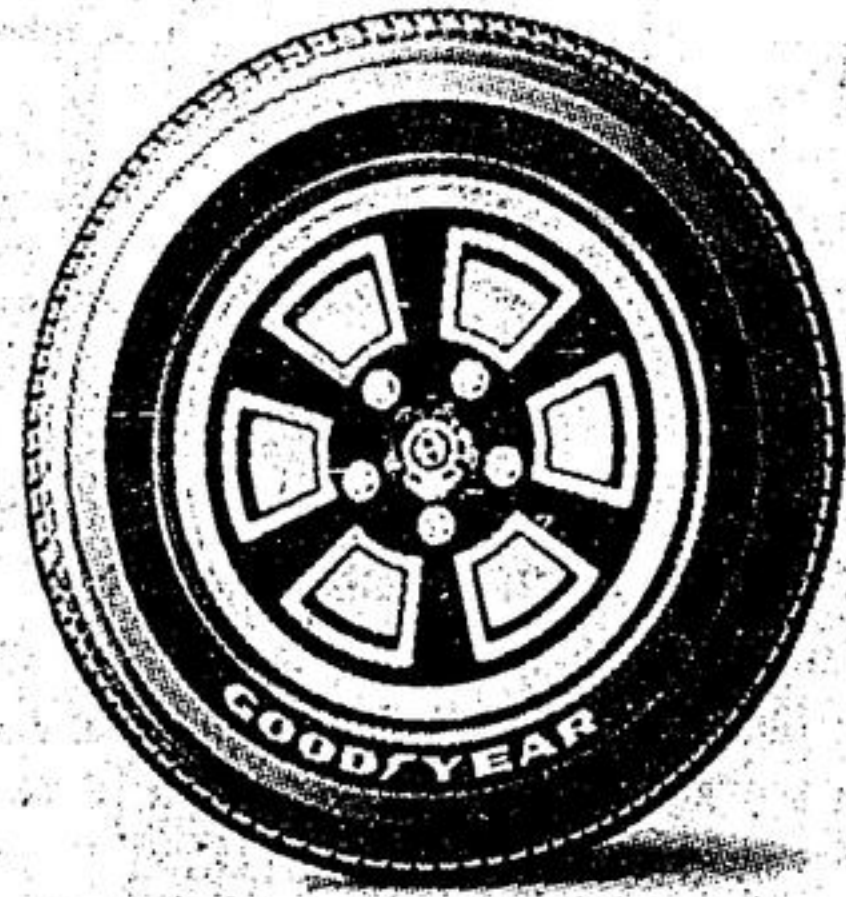
