Mayor and councillor square off at meeting

A verbal scuffle between Stouffville Mayor Fran Sainsbury and Councillor Wayne Emmerson last Tuesday broke out near the end of the council session over a planned meeting with local business people.

Councillor Emmerson was to arrange a meeting with Richard Crispi, Mayor Sainsbury, the business owners of 153 Main Street West and himself. The mayor accused him of holding the meeting without all present.

"Madame mayor, the meeting has not been held," asserted Councillor Emmerson.

"Well then, did you go to each individual owner?" she asked.

"No, Madame Mayor, I did not."

"Did you phone each of them?"

"No, I did not. I had a cup of coffee in the Towne Restaurant."

"Well then - I received phone calls from three of them," she concluded.
