Ball League asks parks upgrade

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Stating his case before Council Tuesday, Myers said proper lighting had been promised for several seasons at the ball field in Vandorf, without result.
This project has the support of Councillor Margot Marshall. However, local electricians refuse to submit quotes, claims Engineering Co-ordinator Paul Whitehouse.
He's hopeful the Stouffville Hydro Commission will offer assistance.
The Association has submitted a list of 14 requests. These include re-alignment of floodlights on all diamonds; installation of new players' benches and screened-in dugouts; construction of an extended four-foot fence along the first and third base lines at Stouffville's Diamond 1; improved accessibility to washrooms during night games and on weekends; the creation of a tree-planting program for Diamonds 2 and 3; installation of a safety screen along the front of the grandstand; the spraying of garbage to prevent swarming of wasps; installation of new home plates and pitchers' mounds at all three Stouffville diamonds; erection of a batter's and pitcher's warm-up cage behind the grandstand and creation of a trophy display case at the Rec. Centre rather than Latcham Hall.
The Community Ball Association will discuss the Town's responses when it meets again April 6.

Longo's the main ingredient
PARMESAN CHICKEN
6 chicken legs
150 ml. soft bread crumbs
100 ml. grated fresh Parmesan cheese
200 ml. milk
20 ml. chopped fresh parsley
1/4 cup 2% milk
175 ml. butter or margarine
7 ml. Dijon mustard
4 ml. Worcestershire sauce
1/2 tsp. garlic clove, finely chopped
Preheat oven. Remove skin and bone legs. Combine breadcrumbs, cheese, parsley and salt. Melt butter, add garlic, mustard and Worcestershire sauce; stir and cool to lukewarm. Dip chicken pieces in butter mixture and roll in breadcrumb mixture to coat completely. Place chicken in baking dish large enough to space evenly. Pour remaining butter mixture over chicken. Bake in moderate oven until tender, basting once or twice during cooking.
Temperature: 180°C (350°F)
Cooking time: about 45 minutes

SPINACH AND BACON SALAD
1-283 g package fresh spinach
1/2 cup sliced onion, chopped
3 slices of bacon, sliced
50 ml. white vinegar
1 ml. salt
1 ml. dry mustard
0.5 ml. pepper
Wash spinach well in a large pan of warm water; dry method with paper towel. Place in bowl. Add onion. Fry bacon until crisp. Add vinegar, salt, mustard and pepper. Bring to boil and pour over spinach. Mix well and serve immediately.
Yield: 6 servings
