A farmer all his life

MARKHAM — Rev. Grant Sloss and Rev. Winston Thurton conducted the funeral service from the Markham Missionary Church, March 28, for Clarence Hoover, following his passing three days previous in Scarborough Centenary Hospital.

Mr. Hoover, 88, had been a patient there almost two years.

Born on the farm that has been a Hoover family homestead through four generations, Mr. Hoover was the son of Ben and

Margaret (Raymer) Hoover. He attended Mt. Joy Public School.

Fifty-two years ago last October, he married Mary Barkey and together they raised a son, Don, now living at Leaskdale and a daughter, Florence, at home. There are two grandchildren, Allan and John.

Mr. Hoover was highly respected, both in the community and within the membership of the
