## Reduce calving problems

A recent article from beef specialist John Field reminds us the spring calving season is underway.

Smart cattlemen are keeping a close eye on their herds day and night, watching for difficult or problem calvings.

Two-year-old heifers are particularly vulnerable to calving difficulties.

By being there, the cattleman can often save not only the calf, but the mother as well.

It would be nice to have a herd in which all cows have their calves by themselves, quickly and without assistance. But this won't likely ever happen.

By proper selection and breeding, however, calving difficulties can be reduced from as high as 50 per cent to as low as 10 per cent or less.

Keeping a record of calving ease of cow families is one way to find replacement heifers that are likely to calve easily.

Breeding to sires that are known to leave easy-calving traits is another.
