New program Kinder-Music the 'key' to fun

An innovative music program for Kindergarten students — dubbed 'Kinder-Music' — has concluded a 10-week session at the home of Ardis Morrison, Stouffville. Daughter Adrienne was one of the participants. Teacher Gabrielle Unter-

mann, a Claremont resident, has a university degree in music, and has taught at schools in Newfoundland, British Columbia and on a reserve in northern Saskatchewan. She is presently on the staff of the Lifetime Learning Centre in Richmond Hill, where she

teaches music to children between the ages of four and 11. The idea for Kinder-Music Stouffville came out of a chance meeting between Ardis and Gabrielle in the IGA parking lot, where Gabrielle's car had broken down. The two women started talking and the idea of getting a group of young children together to learn music began to evolve. Ardis approached Adrienne's Kindergarten teacher and asked if she could suggest names of other students who might be interested in the program. As a result, a group of children had their first lesson in January. Using a workbook with a color-coded diagram of the keyboard, the students can learn to distinguish between different notes. "They go to the piano and play their own little tunes," observes Ardis. Classes also include games, songs, coloring, movement and the use of the piano and rhythm instruments, with the emphasis on learning through play. The idea of the program is to give the children a basic understanding of musical concepts which can be built on as they progress. It's obvious the children are thoroughly enjoying their new found skills, and Ardis hopes she can persuade Gabrielle to return for another session.

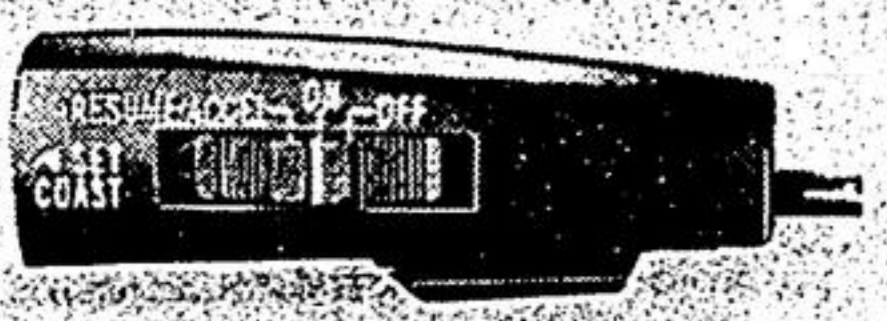
