## Reunion stirs up memories for former Clipper Watson

By BRUCE STAPLEY When the oldtimers of Markham-Stouffville hockey assemble for their reunion May 12, the man at the microphone will be a still-robust 57-year-old who remembers his own day in the sun as if it were yesterday.

Bud Watson, who will be master of ceremonies at the reunion, played for the Stouffville Clippers team that won the Ontario Senior B championship in 1951.

the Unionville-Markham area, currently resides in Unionville and works as residential manager of a sizeable heating and air conditioning firm in the Beaver Creek business section.

He remembers playing hockey as a child on a pond in Unionville, then on an outdoor rink where Crosby Memorial Arena now stands.

"I played in the THL and the King Clancy League from the age of 11, from Pee Wee through Junior. I played with the Unionville Jets Junior Ds, Cs and Bs, and won the scoring title twice."

Watson would go on to play Junior A hockey with Stratford in 1948, then joined the Clippers in 1951 for one year.

"When I was with Stratford, George Armstrong had just left to play for the Toronto Mariboros. I remember playing against Glenn Hall while I was there. And then there was the exhibition game we played against Harry Sinden and his Lyndhurst Motors team that went to play in the Olympics in Europe."




