Nine medals won Stouffville girl steps out

Stouffville dancer Patricia Norton knows the steps that make up a promising future. Just 12, she picked up a total of nine medals in two recent dance competitions. In early May, at the Lions-sponsored Newmarket Festival, she earned five medals, placing first in the cabaret duet, cabaret group and demi-character solo categories, while taking a third-place finish in the tap group and jazz solo areas.

The following week, she accomplished a similar feat by walking away with another four medals at a competition hosted by the British Association Teachers of Dancing. Capturing gold medals in the categories of cabaret duet, cabaret group and demi-character solo, along with a silver in the jazz solo competition, she fared extremely well under the tough scrutiny of the British Association examiners.

"I was nervous at the Newmarket Festival because I was trying something new," says Patricia. Indeed, this was the first time she had competed in two of her five medal-winning categories.

Her story begins four years ago, when she first took an interest in dance.

"I used to skate, but got hurt so I wanted to try something else," she says.

After watching her mother at jazz-exercise classes, Patricia decided she would like to try a children's class.

Upon finding a school, she enrolled and began progressing at an extraordinary rate.

"She's a natural," claims her mother, who takes her to classes four times a week at both Michele Green's Dance Centre and Margo's School of Dance.

While spending a great deal of time at the studio, the straight-A student at St. Mark's Catholic School also maintains a variety of other interests.

"I like to play tennis, baseball and soccer and enjoy swimming during the summer," she says. These diversions keep life "normal."

As her mother says, "She only dances for the fun of it."

Aside from her role as a dance student, Patricia also assists in teaching the younger children.

"In two years, I will be eligible for my teacher's certificate," she states.

And while becoming a dance instructor or professional dancer are potential goals for Patricia, she hasn't yet charted a career path.

Besides, "I'm only 12," she says.
