## Volunteer drive at Red Cross

A summer shortage has created a crisis for the York Region Red Cross' vital Homemaker Service and a job opportunity for high school, college, and university students.

The Red Cross urgently needs summer employees, including high school students, so it can continue to provide in-home support to its elderly, disabled and young family clients throughout the region.

The Homemakers Service is faced with operating this summer with less than half its normal workforce of 28 Homemakers.

"That means our Homemakers may not be able to reach all the service's regular clients and will have to reduce services to others if we don't get more help," says Katy Anderson, Red Cross branch executive director.

Red Cross Homemakers are paid \$6.21 per hour and because the service covers York Region from Georgina to Markham, access to a car is essential. Travel expenses are paid.

Homemaker supervisor Lenore Tanchuk says she is looking for people interested in the welfare of others, able to work independently, who will show initiative, and who will understand the value of performing the essential acts of daily living for individuals and families unable to do so for themselves.

"A sense of humor is essential," she says.

New employees will receive a week's orientation and in-home training with an experienced Homemaker.
