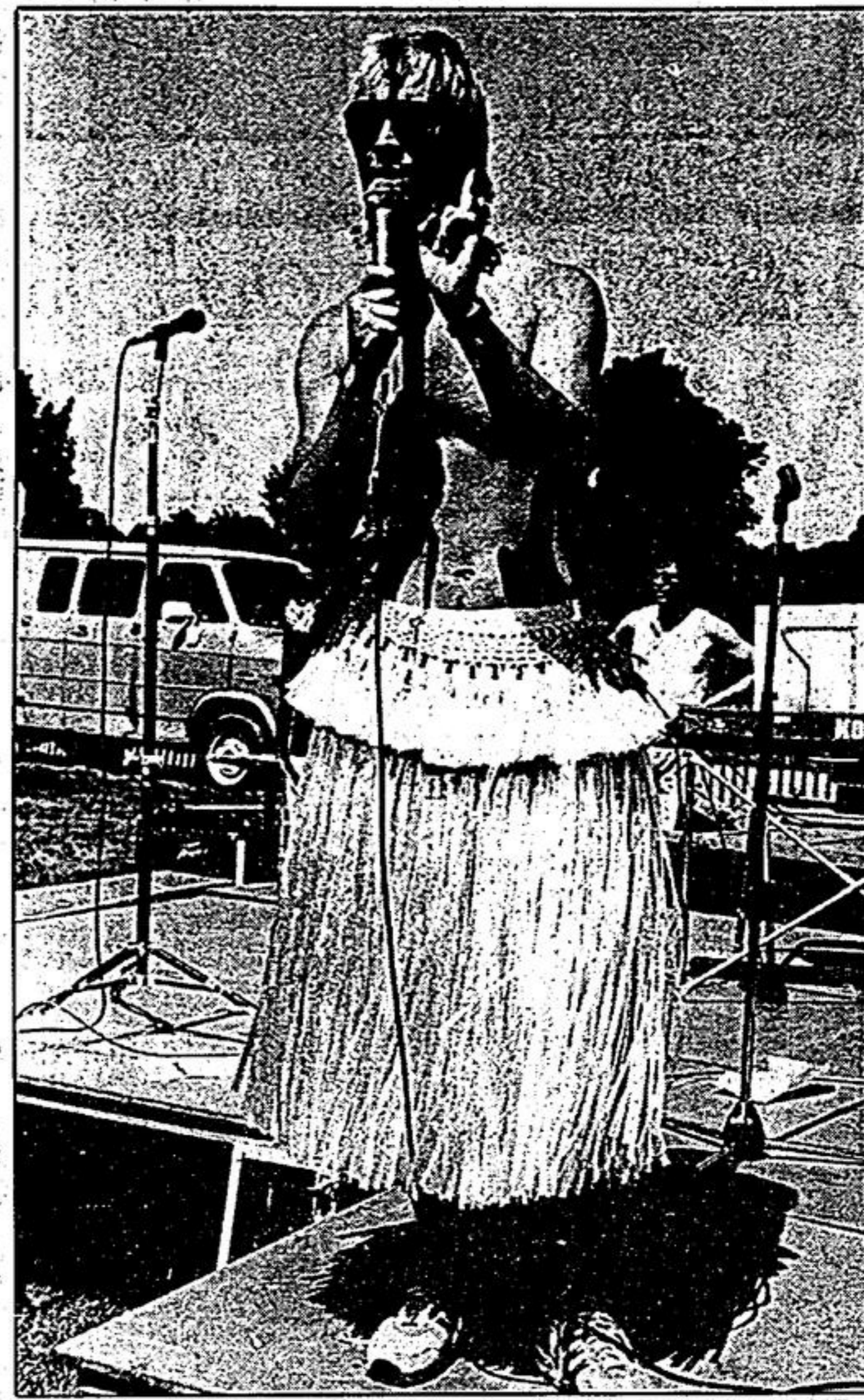
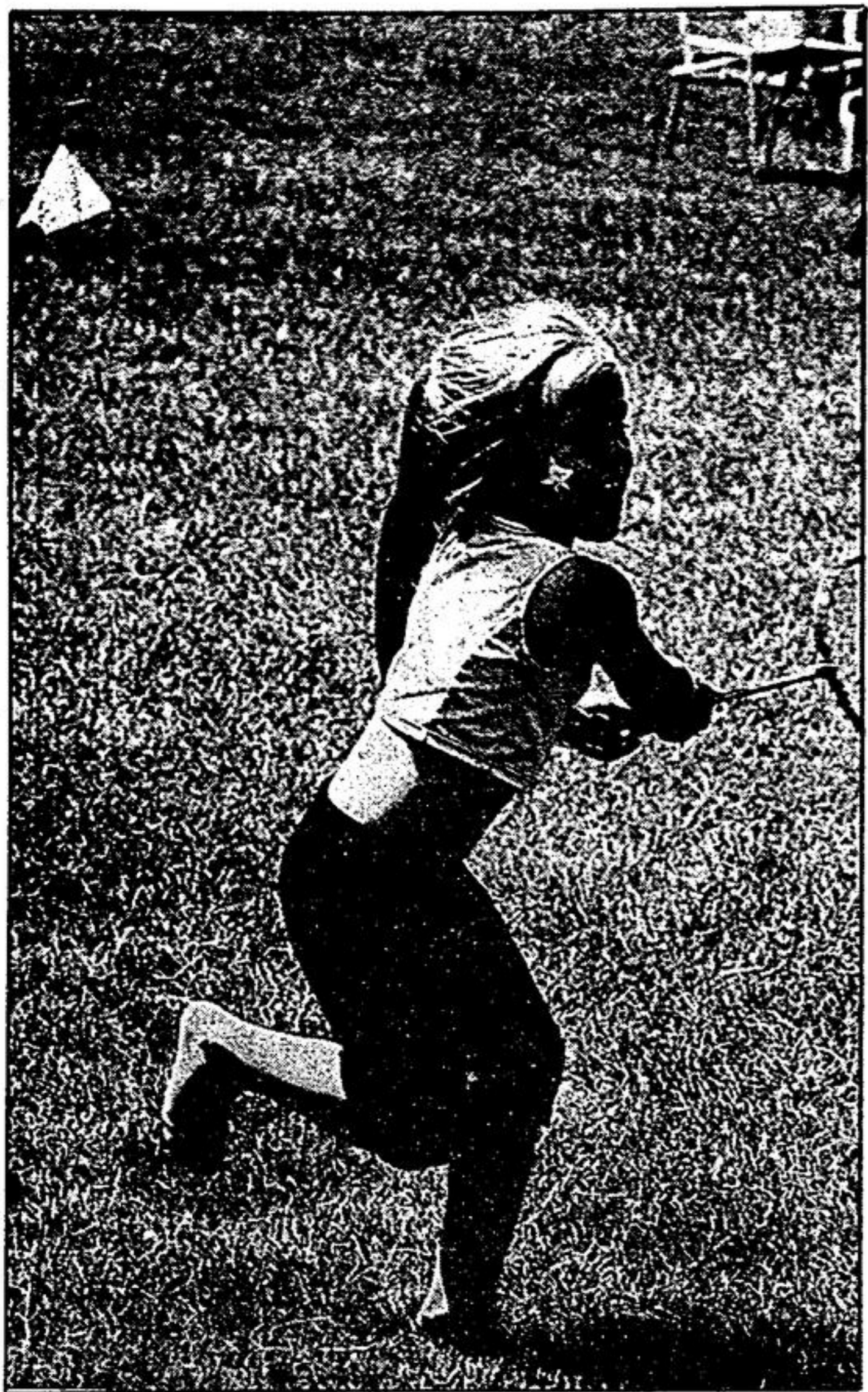


Canada Day up Canada way

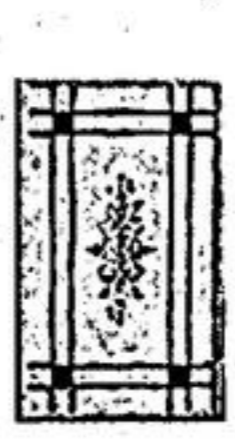
