Pictures of Bruce's Mill sought

Local residents are being asked to search their attics and closets for memorabilia to help in the restoration of an historic flour mill.

The Metropolitan Toronto and Region Conservation Authority is undertaking the renovation of the original mill at Bruce's Mill on Stouffville Rd. It is hoped that old photographs and original documents can be found to assist the Authority in its efforts to return the building to its original form.

The mill, which was constructed in 1858, belonged to the Bruce family until it was acquired by the Authority in the late 1950s. It is one of only a few of the approximately 1,500 mills that once existed in Ontario.

The mill is considered significant because it contains machinery dating to the early 1900s, enabling an authentic restoration. Authority officials are hopeful the addition of the sought-after artifacts will help in the mill's restoration, serving to illustrate its historic importance to the community.

The Authority's Community Officer, Craig Smith, says fundraising to help finance the project began two years ago, and that \$178,000 has been donated so far. Some work has already been completed.

"The water wheel has been replaced," says Mr. Smith.

The mill should be open to the public by fall, with a permanent display, an audio-visual presentation, and a brochure.

Mr. Smith feels the machines will generate interest in the agricultural roots of York Region. "The machines will be in working order. We got a hold of some of the original equipment catalogues for them, and that helped us restore the equipment."
