Church celebrates 100th anniversary

Hannah Linton's Luscious Pie Contest and Auction, to be held at Claremont United Church on Saturday, September 23rd, couldn't be a more fitting way to celebrate the church's 100th anniversary.

When Claremont United was first built in 1889, it was Mrs. Hannah Linton, whose great-granddaughter, Edith Stickwood is now a member of the congregation, who was given the honor of laying the cornerstone. That was by no means the only task she had set herself on that special day however; she also found time to bake 40 pies, for the celebration.

It was that fact, and a magazine article, which first prompted the idea of a centennial pie contest, explains church member Karen Marks. "It seemed a proper way to mark the occasion, since it was the first time I'd heard of one lady making 40 pies in one day," she laughs.

"I sort of stole the idea from a story in *Canadian Living*, about a community who did something along the same lines as this and raised money for their needs." Although it's the first year they've done it, "it's specifically for the anniversary," she says.

It could end up being a tradition. "If it's a success it might become an annual event," acknowledges Karen.

The categories for entries in the pie contest are: apple, other fruit, filled, savory, and chocolate. There are also special categories for junior contestants (up to 12), seniors and men. Eligible contestants can enter as many categories as they like. Pies should be brought to the church for judging between 11 a.m. and 12 noon on September 23rd.

The money raised will go to a special anniversary project which has yet to be finalized, explains Minister Louise Barrie. "We're still getting estimates on one thing we'd very much like to do, which is to fix the stairs, because they're high and we want to make them more accessible to seniors. At the moment people have great difficulty using them."

On the same day as the pie sale and auction, a special red and white autograph quilt, made by the United Church Women and featuring almost 500 embroidered names, will also be offered to auction. A special service will be held at the church on October 15 to mark the centennial.

1st Instalment due — August 18th, 1989

2nd Instalment due — October 20th, 1989

FINAL Tax bills have now been mailed. Rate payers who have not received their bills should make immediate application to the Municipal Tax Department.

The PENALTY charged for non payment of 1989 taxes is one and one-quarter (1 1/4) percent imposed on the first day of default and on the first day of each month thereafter.

Failure to receive a tax bill does not eliminate the responsibility for payment of taxes nor the penalty charge for late payment.


