

# New options coming for students

York Region students may have several innovative options in the 1990 school year, depending on the outcome of provincial meetings.

The Ministry of Skills Development, in co-ordination with the Ministry of Education has announced three new apprenticeship programs for senior secondary school students.

Beginning with Windsor, Temiskaming and Wellington boards, education boards throughout Ontario are seeking the necessary approval to begin the projects.

Pat Sherbin, senior media relations officer of the Ministry of Skills Development says the board must first get approval from the Ministry of Education, then the approval of the Ministry of Skills.

The three programs, the Ontario Traineeship, the High School Apprenticeship and the Summer Experience, are aimed at giving the students practical work experience in one of 66 trades.

The Ontario Traineeship program allows workers to combine one or two years of on-the-job training with formal in-school training. Though the initial number of trainees will only be

200, it is hoped that within three years that number will reach 2,000.

The High School Apprenticeship will allow students the option of work during school, all the while earning credit. Employers in the program will

pay the equivalent of regular apprenticeship programs.

The final program under consideration is the Summer Experience which allows students a chance to gain work-related experience and develop job skills at the same time.

# Take care on highways

Recently, a good friend of mine asked me why there are so many car accidents these days in York Region.

Hwy. 7 is so heavily travelled these days that drivers must learn to sit back and take their time when driving anywhere.

One of the major causes of car accidents is speeding. Speed is a killer when it is too fast for the condition of light, weather, road, traffic, vehicle and driver. Excessive speed is the most frequent violation noted on reports of fatal collisions today.

Collision severity increases dramatically at speeds around 80 km. The chance of death or serious injury in a traffic collision doubles for each 15 km speed increase over 80 km. Keep the following in mind:

- Schedule trips so you provide ample driving time (especially travelling to and from your place of work).
- Be alert for speed limit signs and heed them. Lower speed as conditions warrant.
