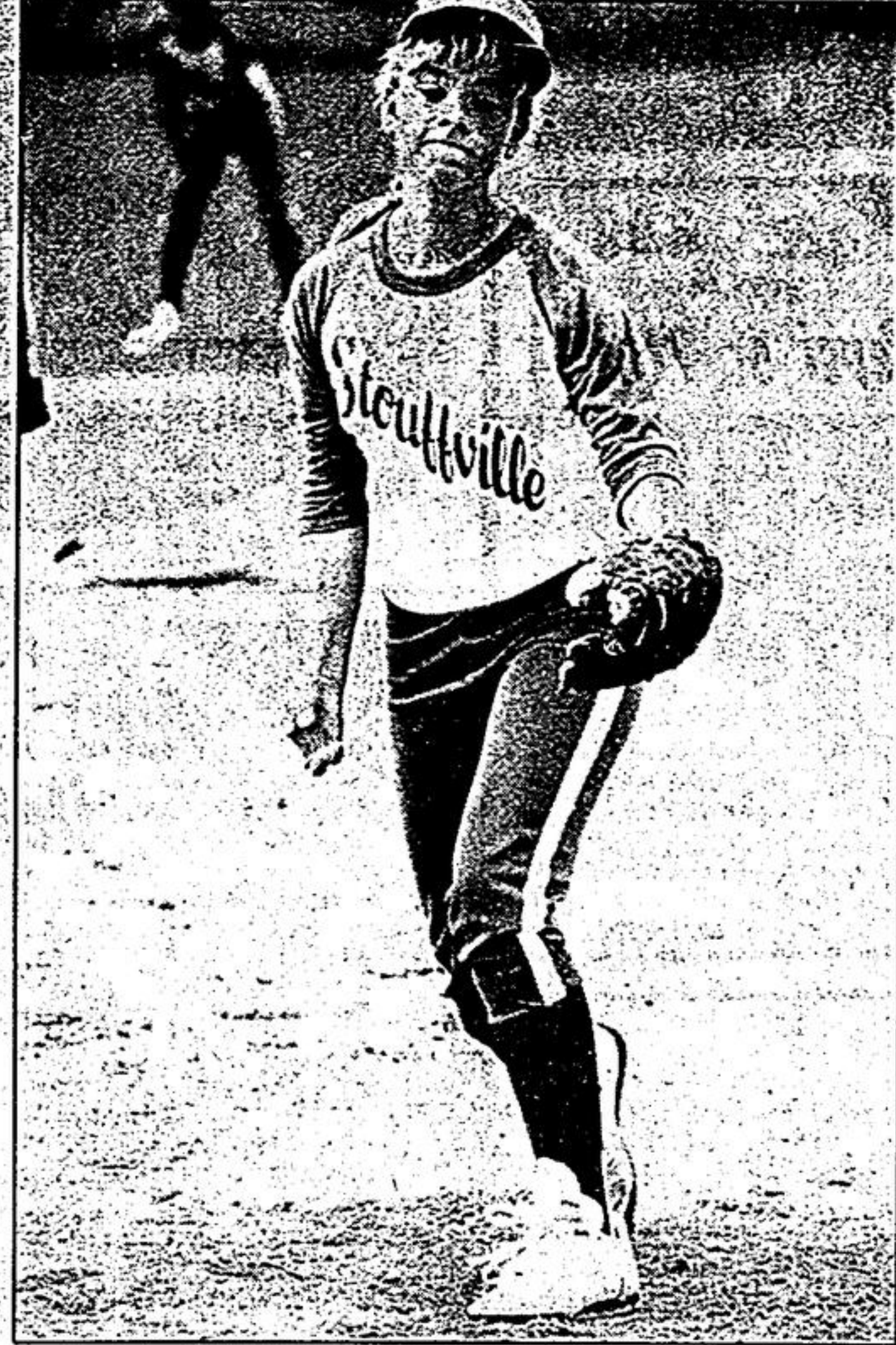




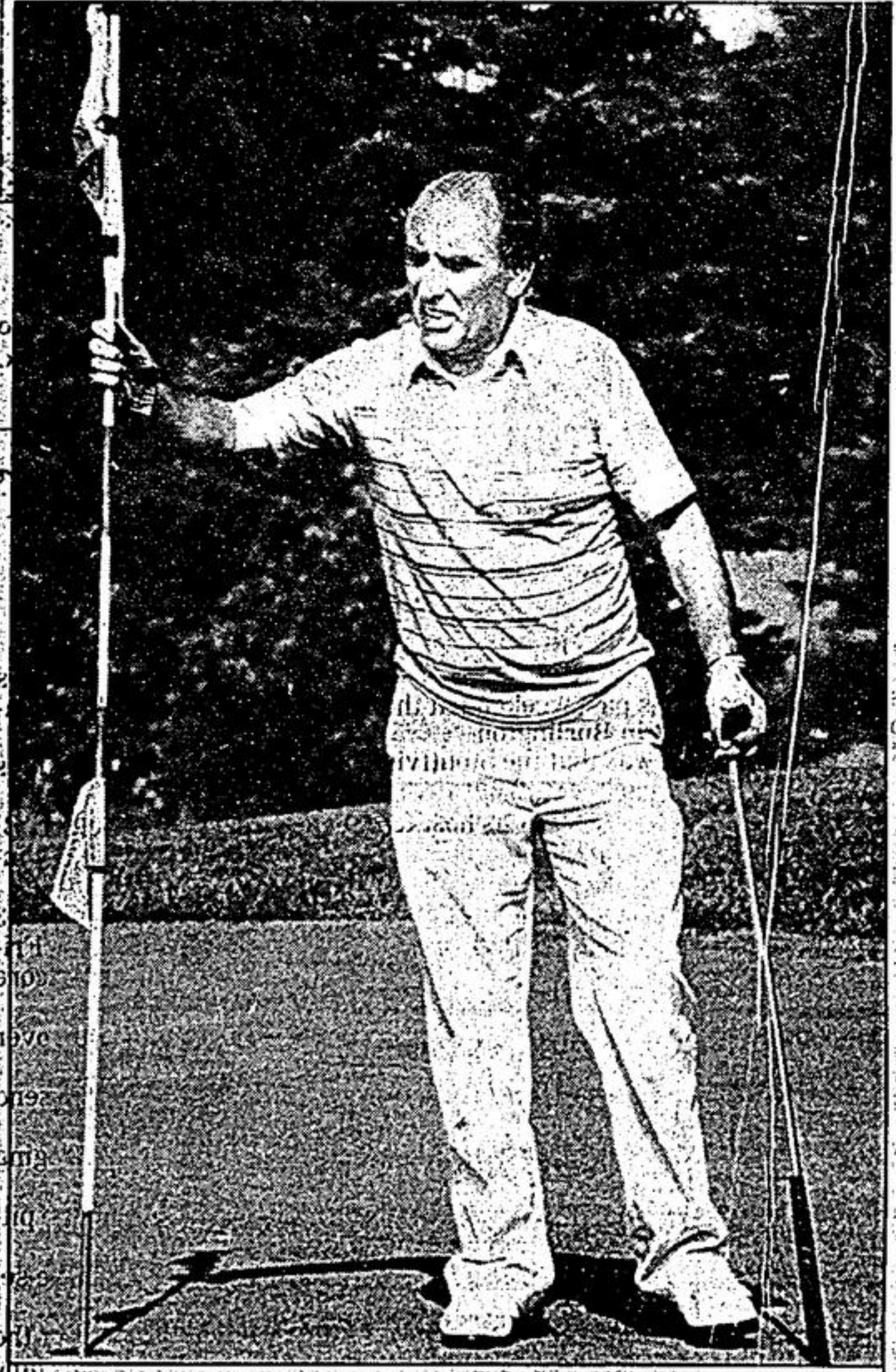
Squirt action
