

# Ballinger gets new posting as assistant in municipal affairs

Durham-York MPP Bill Ballinger is changing hats at Queen's Park. He's the newly-appointed assistant to the minister of municipal affairs.

"I'm very excited about this new position," he told the Tribune.

Formerly the parliamentary assistant to the minister of natural resources, Mr. Ballinger

will now concentrate his efforts in helping John Sweeney

Appointed by Ontario Premier David Peterson last Wednesday, Mr. Ballinger will now tackle issues closer to his appeal and experience with municipal affairs.

He adds his new job will give him a provincial outlook and his past experiences at the municipal level will allow him to keep local needs in mind.

Although he's not sure what his new job will involve, he says he will be meeting with the minister this week to discuss future projects.

## Ballantrae bid on hold

The Whitchurch-Stouffville planning committee is placing a "hold" on a rezoning proposal for land in Ballantrae until a municipal water supply is available.

The Country Stop restaurant and gas bar owners want to rezone less than one acre of land on the east side of Hwy. 48 from rural residential to highway commercial.

A public hearing was held at the town offices in Stouffville last Tuesday to introduce the proposal and only one resident showed up to voice her concerns about garbage that makes its way to her neighboring property.

"I don't mind them building but my lot to the south gets a lot of garbage," Eileen Madill told the committee. The resident wanted to ensure a fence would be erected if the rezoning went through and the owner said he would meet the request.

Ward 2 Councillor Ron Robb told the committee the resident in his ward is a "very good corporate citizen in Ballantrae" and ensured "if he says he will rectify the problem (by erecting a fence) I am sure that will be done."

A highway commercial zoning would allow the owners to open shops ranging from a business office to a veterinary clinic but both the owners and council agreed to strike several uses from a list of otherwise permitted businesses under highway commercial zoning.

## Lindsay woman killed in crash

A Lindsay woman is dead following a two-car crash Sunday morning at Regional Rd. 23 and Hwy. 47 in Uxbridge.

Ontario Provincial Police report that Carol Harrison, 51, was killed when the car she was riding in was involved in the crash at about 10:30 a.m.

Her husband, Douglas, was also injured.

According to OPP reports, a Port Perry man was driving north on Regional Rd. 23 and the Harrisons were driving west on Hwy. 47. The cars collided in the intersection where the two highways meet.

Investigation into the crash is continuing, police say, and charges are pending.
