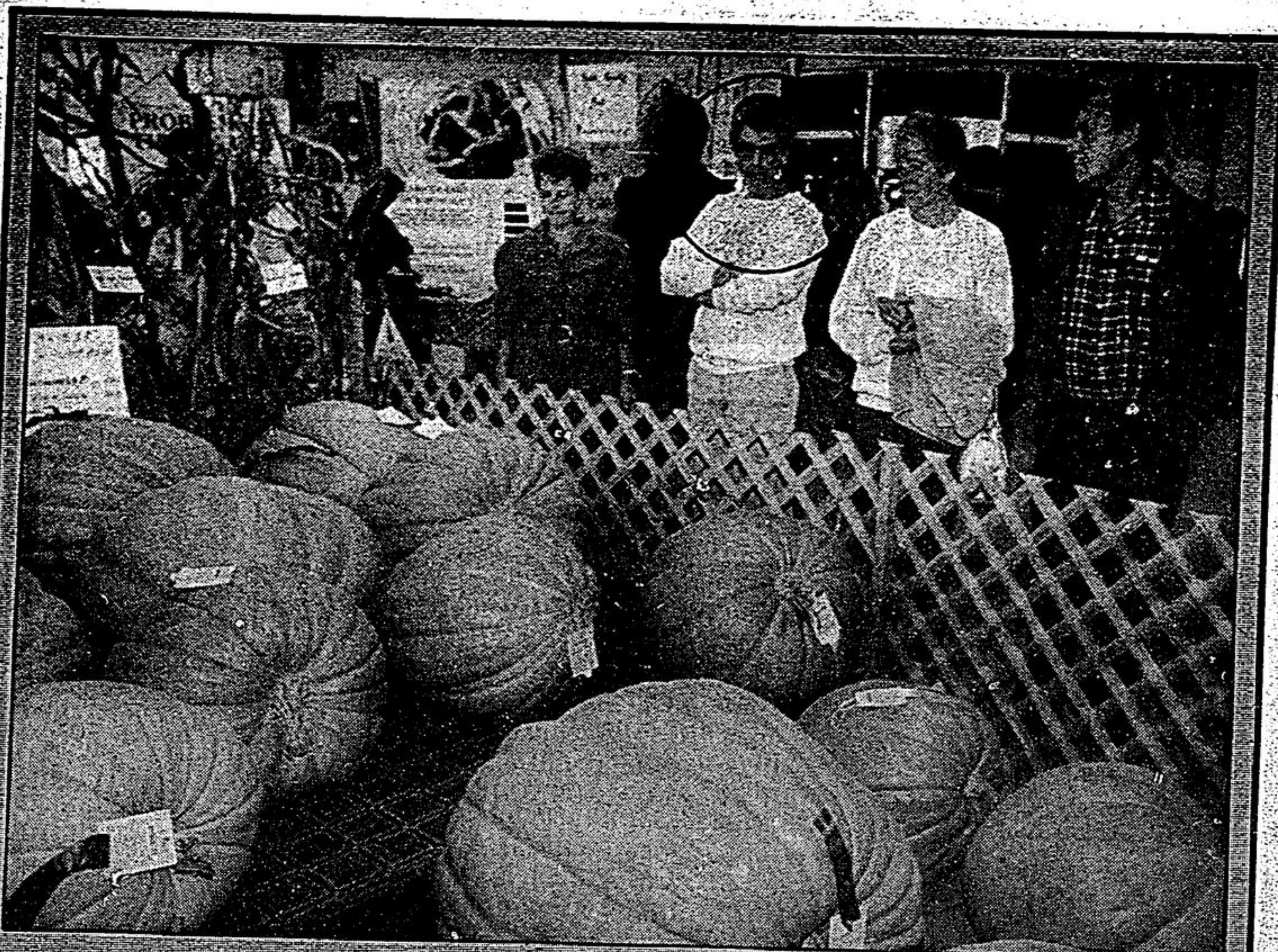

Motorists are warned to 'buckle up'

Local motorists are being warned by York Regional Police to buckle up when driving on area roads.

York Regional police are joining other provincial police forces in stepping up enforcement of seatbelt legislation this month.

Police say motorists who neglect or improperly use seatbelts have a greater chance of being seriously injured or killed in motor vehicle accidents.

According to a release, police officers regularly enforce seatbelt legislation but will "strictly enforce" the law during October.

"Every person must attempt to take the initiative in ensuring that friends and family members are protected through proper use of approved devices which can make the difference between tragedy and safety," York Regional Police Chief Donald Hillock said in the release.
