Nominees for awards are sought

Non-profit community organizations are invited to nominate candidates for the 1990 Ontario Volunteer Service Awards and Outstanding Achievement Awards, the provincial government announced this week.

Volunteer Service Awards recognize five, 10 and 15 years of continuous voluntary service by an individual to a community organization. Eligible organizations include museums, newcomer and settlement service organizations, historical societies, multicultural associations and native groups.

More than 3,000 volunteers receive awards each year in ceremonies held throughout the province.

Fifteen Outstanding Achievement Awards are presented annually in recognition of extraordinary volunteer work. Individuals, non-profit groups and businesses are eligible to receive these awards.

The Outstanding Achievement Awards nominations are mediated by a jury and decisions are based on documentation of the candidate's career as a volunteer.
